BAREFOOT BOY BRITISH BARON

Death of Canadian Railway Builder Recalls Wonderful Story of Advancement.

The death of Lord George Stephen, first baron Mount Stephen, news of whose death was received today, was born in 1829 at Forres in Banffshire, Scotland, the son of William Stephen a carpenter.

As a boy, Stephen played barefooted in the streets of his native village and at an early age was first a shepherd, on the bleak moors nearby, and then a clerk in a draper's store.

Smith and Stephen joined forces with the late J. J. Hill, the Canadian railway magnate who afterwards built a number of railroads in the United States, and the trio acquired the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad, which had failed and had fallen into the hands of its Dutch bondholders.

Before leaving Canada, Lord Mount Stephen divided up his immense fortune, estimated at \$6,000,000, among his relatives in Montreal, retaining enough to support him for the rest of his life.

This lady died in 1896. In 1897 Lord Mount Stephen married, Glan, daughter of Captain R. G. Tufnell, R.N., of London. The title becomes extinct with the death of Lord Mount Stephen.
