HUSKY DOGS IN THE NORTH

They Take Place of Flivver and Horse; Wonderful Value

WINNIPEG, April 25.—The horse or the flivver has no chance with the dog teams in the north-land during the winter season, according to Miss Mary Glendonan, staff writer for the Manitoba Free Press. Dogs are the winter burden bearers of the north. The young men of the towns buy a dog team and toboggan instead of a flivver with which to take the girls riding. On the other hand, pioneers at remote posts do not mush the dogs as sport. The dogs are harnessed when it is necessary to make the round of the trap lines; to replenish the larder; to fetch supplies or mail from the nearest post or to make a hurry-up trip for the doctor.

The only wagon roads north of The Pas and vicinity run to Elm Flon mine, about 100 miles, and from Mile 82 on the Hudson Bay Railway to Herb Lake, about 18 miles. Aside from these roads horses are unknown in the north, and where the horse cannot go the automobile has no chance.

Water in Summer
Northern traffic goes by water in summer and the dogs for their sins of fighting and howling are banished to outlying dog camps. They come into their own again each fall at freeze-up, for then passenger, freight and mail service depends on dog power.

The genuine husky is a cross between the big timber wolf of the north and the collie dog. Many of the present huskies are generations removed from the original cross by which the type was produced. Many other working dogs show points of the husky, all but extinguished in the conglomeration of almost everything doggy.

backs, the rich, smoky silver of their coats which are long and silky, and also by their wolfish howling. Such dogs can not really bark. Some of them weigh 100 pounds, and a load of 100 pounds per dog is not considered excessive. They are fit for work before they are one year old and are good for the hard trips of several hundred miles with a spin of perhaps 60 miles per day, for almost seven years. After that they may be used at easy hauling for two or three years. Fifty miles a day is considered good studding and 2,000 miles in a winter is a conservative estimate of what a dog at regular work will cover.

Dog Languages.
There are different dog languages. "Mush," pronounced moosh generally is used for the start, with "gee" and "haw" for right and left, "whoa" for the stop and other words too numerous and hectic to mention, reserved for the lazy contrary beast. The Indians say "yoo" for the right turn, and an explosive "cha" for the left. The Alaskan, Walter Goyno, uses a monotonous conversational tone with his dogs, starting them with a short whistle and "all right."
