Cranberries are Also En Route—Florida Grapefruit Here; Eggs Becoming Scarcer and Prices Stiffening.

Large quantities of oranges and lemons are expected to arrive on the boats tomorrow and they will be very welcome. They will be dear but many people here will be glad to get them at any price. There is also a considerable shipment of cranberries coming north.

Some fine grapefruit are offering this week at 25c each. They are large and of fine quality. They come all the way from Florida.

There is a slight stiffening in many lines. Eggs are scarcer and it is possible the prices may go higher yet.

Meats remain much the same except that at times it is a little difficult to get some of the joints.

The food controller is continually exhorting everyone to buy what are usually known as meat offals in order to conserve the better joints and allow for a larger export overseas.

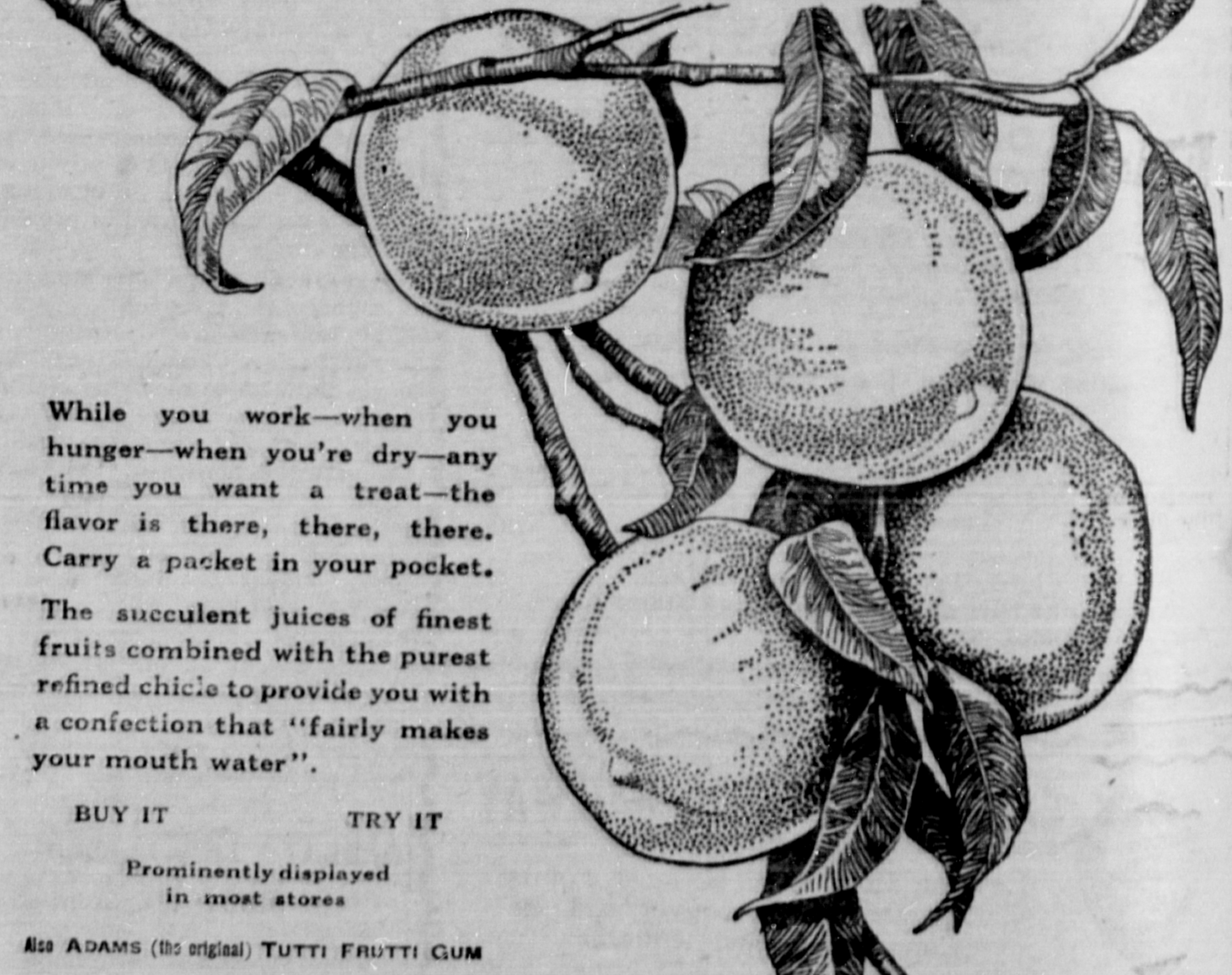
