NEW YORK, June 29: (CP)-Joe Louis retained his world's heavyweight boxing championship by scoring a fourth round technical knockout over Tony Galento at Yankee Stadium last night. Galento put up a game fight but was outgeneralled and outfought by Louis who cut him to ribbons. Louis was knocked down in first and
