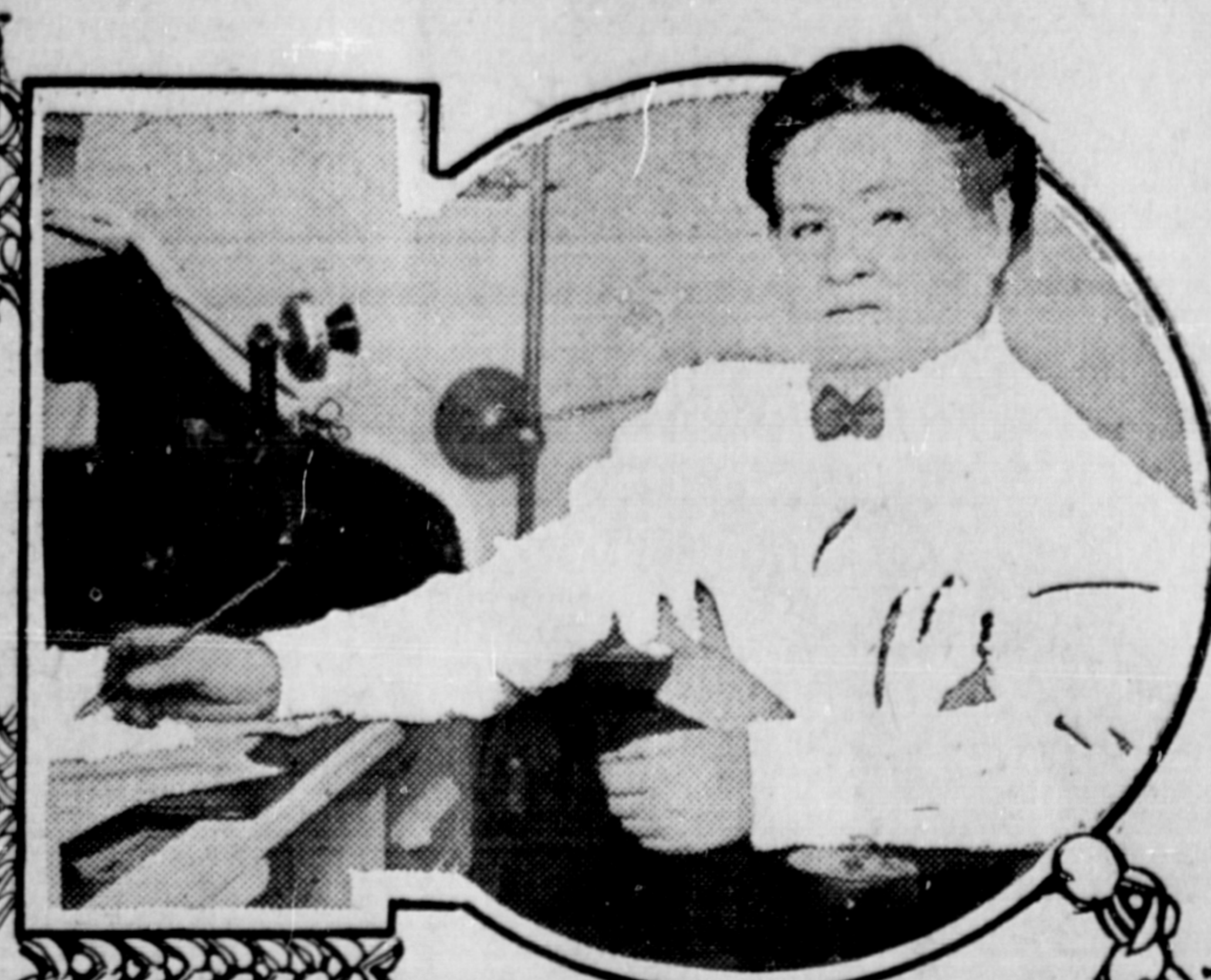

## BEAUTIFUL HOME FOR SUFFRAGE WORKERS

Mrs. O. H. P. Belmont's recent purchase of two houses on Forty-first street, New York, gives the suffragists of the United States their only permanent headquarters.

The property purchased and remodeled at a total cost of \$400,000 in the name of the Political Equality League, of which Mrs. Belmont is president, will fulfill the demands of both home and club.

One of the houses has been converted into a lodging where on the average modern income a woman can live comfortably, while the other is equipped as an up-to-date club, the scene of all the association's activities.

Here are the official headquarters, where the officers of the league will meet with their followers, a vast lecture hall, used not only for meetings of the various clubs composing the league, and lectures on suffrage, political economy and other subjects, but for entertainments. Here, too, on Wednesday evenings of each week Mme. Nordica will give vocal instructions.

The club will be equipped with all of the facilities of the modern club, dining and tea rooms, libraries, an up-to-date kitchen,

and a "beauty parlor" where all sorts of toilet articles may be purchased.

An artistic bill board characteristic of the purpose of the organization, inviting attention at the entrance of the club, records the aim and purpose of the league and its various activities.

When the buildings are completed they will be crowned by a life sized figure of a woman in bronze, holding in her uplifted hand the American flag and the Belmont suffrage flag.

Sault Ste. Eight vessels will take part and the manoeuvres will be held at Manitou Island. No information has been received here of the withdrawal of the protests by Canada, but it is supposed arrangements have been made satisfactory to Ottawa.

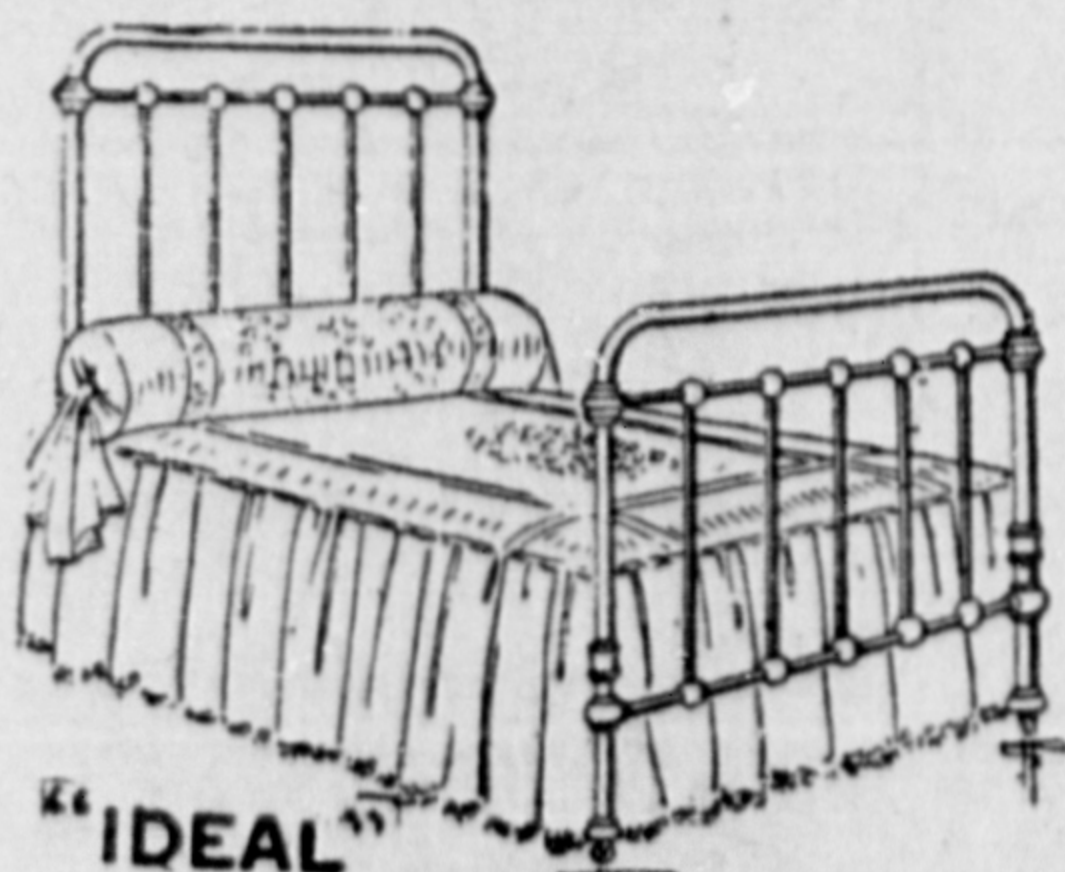

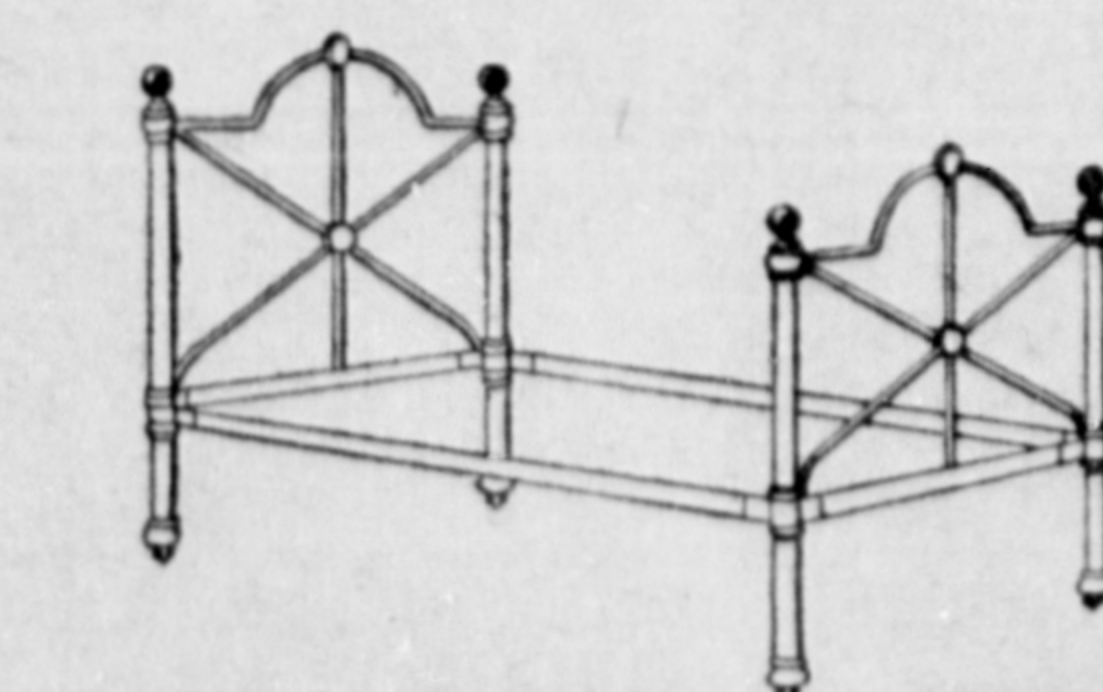

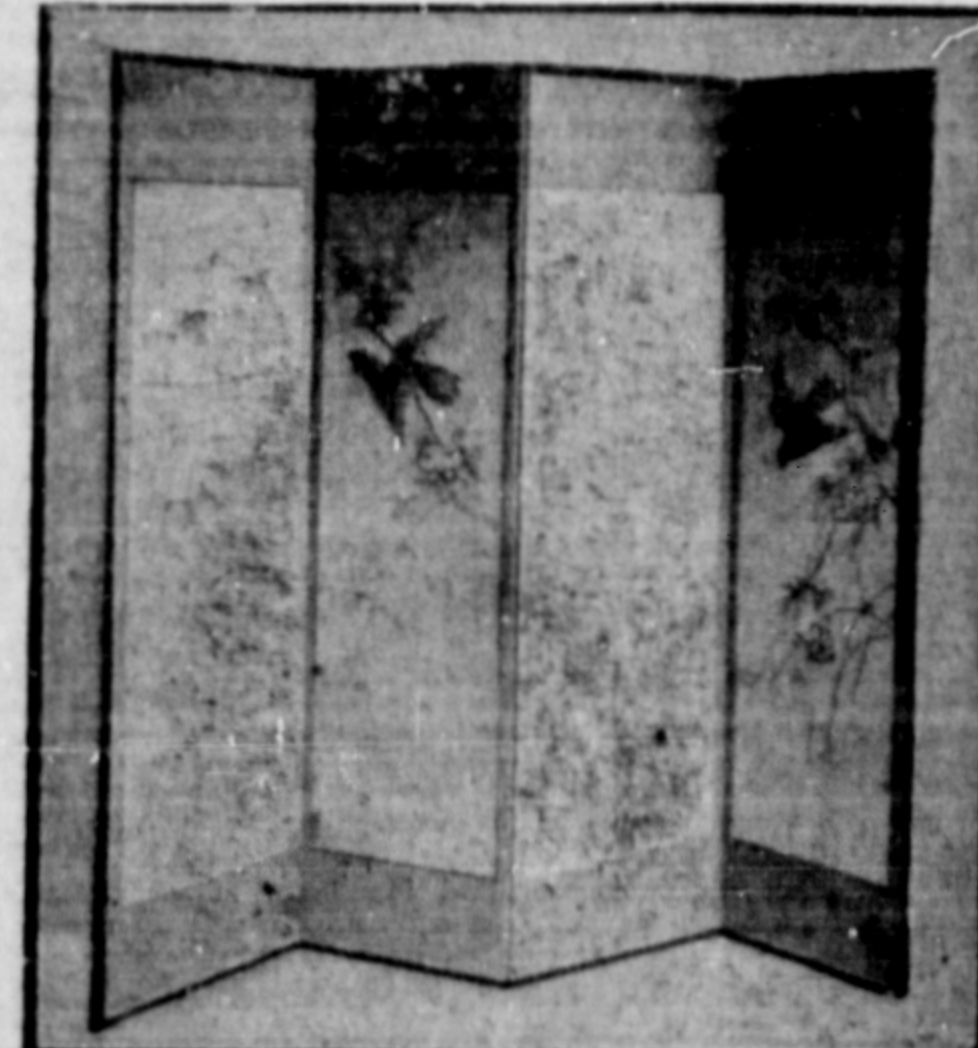
