USE DOG TEAMS TO GROUNDHOG

British Columbia Anthracite Coal Outfit Start Getting in Supplies to Begin Development on Vast Coal Field.

During the week Frank Jackson of the B. C. Anthracite Coal, Ltd., despatched ten toboggans, loaded with tools and supplies, to the Groundhog Mountain coal fields, where the company has a large area of land, says the Omineca Miner. The valuable coal measures which have been uncovered by the prospecting operations of the last three seasons are to be developed scientifically, in accordance with plans recently prepared, and a crew of a dozen men will leave shortly to begin preliminary work. The river trail to Groundhog will be kept open as long as the tobogganing is good, as Mr. Jackson intends to use every available dog team for the transportation of supplies, in order that there may be no shortage before pack trains can reach the upper Skeena camp.

The samples were exceptionally fine specimens of the Cup ore and the directors of the company here were particularly pleased to know that this class of ore has been found on the Duke vein.

NEARING THE ORE

Harris Mines Making Good Progress in Big Tunnel.

Progress on the Harris mines tunnel, near Hazelton, shows the work to have reached a point 274 feet in, and approximately 50 feet from the vein. The intervening distance will probably be covered before the end of the month. Following the expected disclosure at depth of the big ore shoot, it is planned to start a new tunnel at a point low enough to give 500 feet of depth on the vein.

The satisfactory condition of the company's treasury, with the economical methods of administration adopted, should enable the Harris mines to place their property on a shipping and paying basis without the sale of additional treasury stock.
