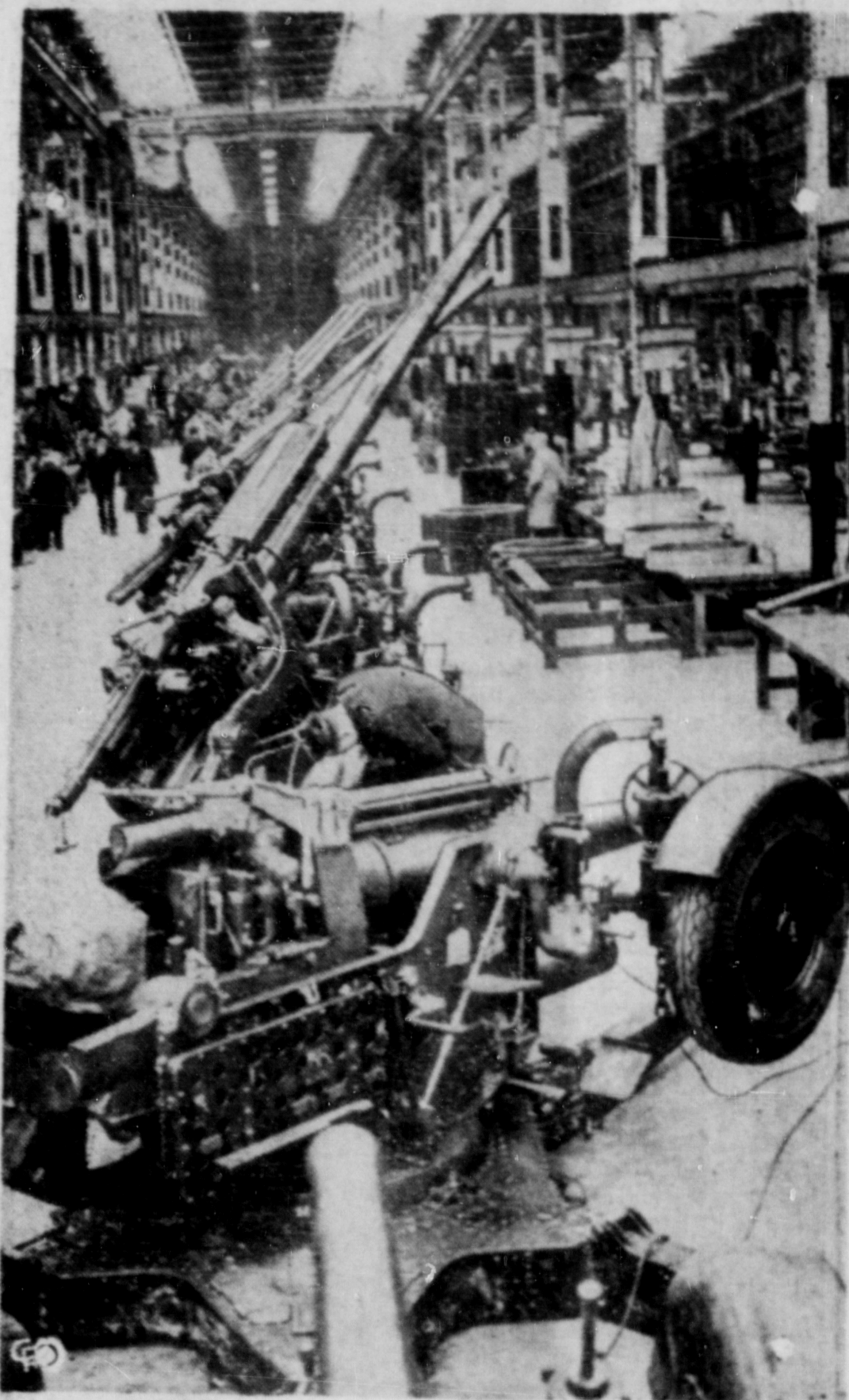

TOKYO, November 23: (CP)—Premier Nobuyuki Abe announced today that Japan would keep troops in China until "China is entirely free from the Communist menace."

In a statement published by the Japanese press, the Premier said that garrisons would operate under an anti-Communist pact which Japan would conclude shortly with the new Chinese government.

Bags For Canada's Sailors On the Seas and in Harbors for Christmas

TORONTO, Nov. 23: (CP)—Full of surprises, more than 5,000 "ditty" bags will swing from hammocks on Canadian naval ships on two seas or Canadian harbors on Christmas morning. These junior-size hold-

ed with knitted things and interesting oddments for the sailors' Christmas cheer by women across the Dominion.

Packing the bags, distributed by the Ontario Division of the Navy League of Canada to members and individuals, will be supervised by the women's committee of the league. Individual trinkets may be sent to headquarters here to be included in the Christmas "boxes" and the committee asks that all donors add a cheery note to their merrily-wrapped parcels.

There may be some socks, a muffler, cap, sweater, or a pair of pyjamas for the bulk of the bag. Suggested additional "surprises," include such things as a mouth organ, back of cards, pad of notepaper, pencil, puzzle, game, dominoes, nuts, chewing gum, hard candy, chocolate.

senders continue to see that "special" charges are supplied the extras.

There are heavy readers in navy and Ontario headquarters seeking 50,000 books and magazines as donations so there will be plenty of reading matter waiting for sailors afloat and ashore. Books are favorites with sailors as well as mystery yarns, adventure stories and illustrated magazines or periodicals for lighter moments. Books from the press should be sent direct to the Post coast.

Already some 300 pairs of socks and more than 100 sweaters have been sent to England by the League of Canada in co-operation with the Red Cross Society.
