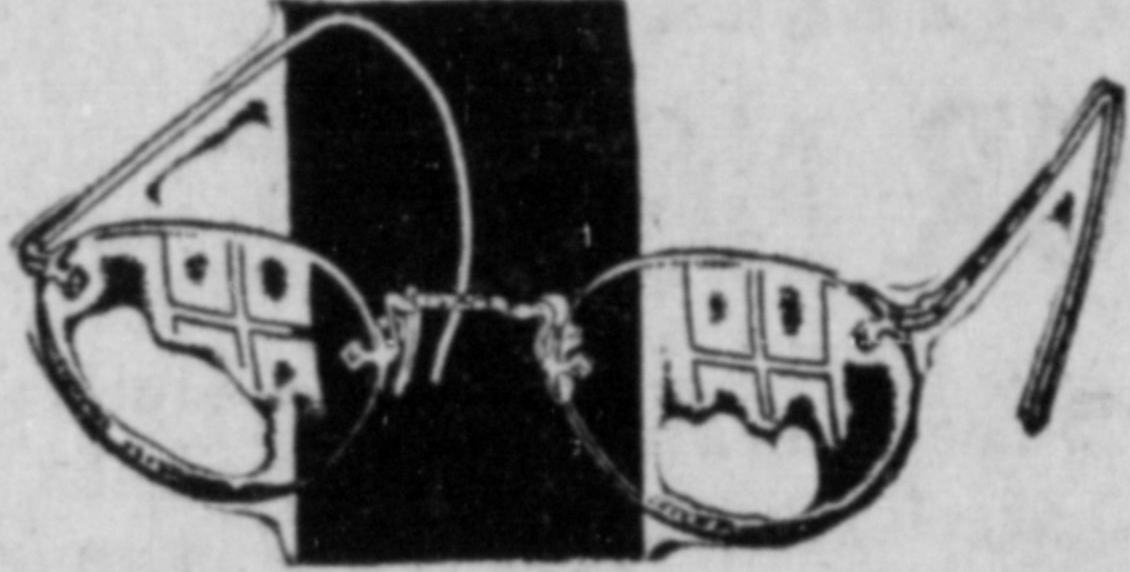
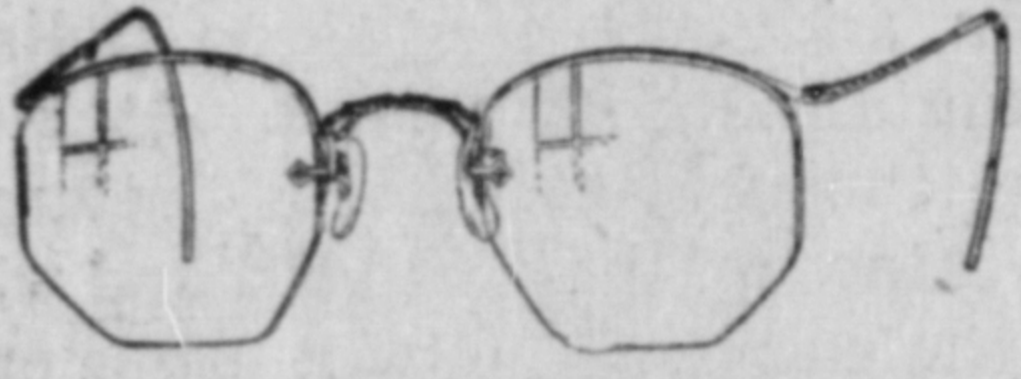

GRACIE IS  
AT JASPER

"Lancashire Lass" Greeted At  
Mountain Resort—Stays In  
King's Cabin

JASPER PARK, August 10:—In the very bungalow where King George and Queen Elizabeth rested during the royal tour in 1939, Gracie Fields relaxed Friday after a hurried journey across the Dominion to fill her concert engagement at Jasper Park Lodge on Saturday. The popular English actress remained at Outlook Cabin and strolled the shores of Lac Beauvert Friday afternoon and, at her own request, today drove to the Glacier of the Angel at Mount Edith Cavell, the 11,000 foot snow peak which was named to commemorate the heroine nurse of the First World War.

Enthusiastic receptions were given Miss Fields upon her arrival at Jasper for her first concert at a resort in the Canadian Rockies. Greeted officially by Major J. A. Wood, superintendent of Jasper National Park, and Robert Somerville, manager of Jasper Park Lodge, Miss Fields also was met by representatives of the Canadian Legion and Lancashire settlers of the district. Presentations were made by Jacqueline Driver, who carried greetings from the Legionnaires, and by Gwen Richardson, whose father served in the last war and is now overseas with an Edmonton regiment.

Pink Run Almost Failure Hereabouts  
This Year — Halibut Landings  
Somewhat Heavier This Week  
—Coast Catch is up  
Considerably

Except for the Queen Charlotte Islands, it looks like an almost complete failure for seine-caught pink salmon in Prince Rupert district this year. With the season having only a week to go, seiners have caught practically no pinks on the mainland so far although a few have been caught in sockeye gill nets. Some 35,000 pinks have been

taken in Massett Inlet on the Queen Charlotte Islands although it is still a little early for the bulk of the run there. Sockeye gill netting as well as seine fishing is to be closed on Skeena and Naas River August 16. For the two or three weeks the sockeye catch in gillnets on Skeena and Naas Rivers, due probably to most unfavorable weather conditions, has fallen off to an average of about ten or twelve fish. It is expected that the closing of gillnetting and seining on the Skeena and Naas Rivers on August 16 will see the cessation of packing operations for the season in the Skeena River area at all canneries except Inverness, Claxton and Prince Rupert which are to remain open for fall fish. Canners on the Queen Charlotte Islands and the southern part of Prince Rupert district, as usual, remain open for the fall seine fishing.

C.P.R. steamer Princess Adelaide, Capt. William Hughes, arrived in port at 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon from the south and sailed at 10 o'clock last evening on her return to Vancouver via waypoints. The Princess Adelaide had on board quite a number of round trip tourists.

Union steamer Cardena, Capt. John Boden, arrived in port at 6:30 this morning from the south and sailed at 8:15 a.m. on her return to Vancouver and waypoints.

Dr. A. L. Pritchard of the Nanaimo Biological Station is paying his annual visit to this district on scientific investigatory duties in connection with salmon migration. After spending a few days in the Naas River area, he is now in the city and expects to visit Massett Inlet before returning south.

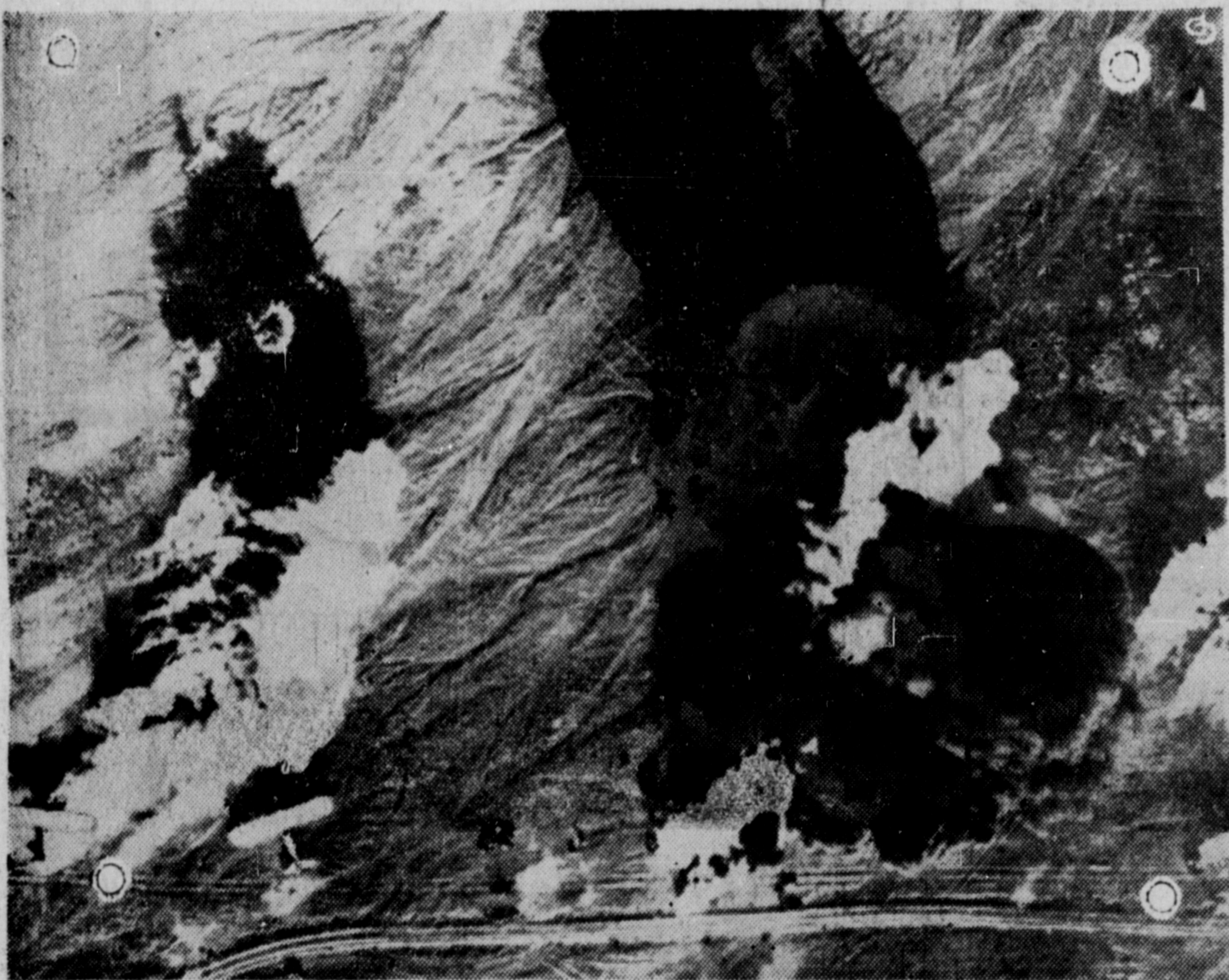
