MISUSE AND ABUSE OF POWER.

John P. McConnell, long well known as the editor and part proprietor of the Vancouver Saturday Sunset, and now editor-in-chief of the Morning Sun, is the Liberal candidate for Yale.

"Speaking generally, I think all thoughtful citizens must come to the conclusion that a government without an opposition cannot be the best kind of government. LIBERALS OF BELLA COOLA ARE REMARKABLY SANGUINE

CONSERVATIVES SORE BECAUSE THEIR PROPOSITION FOR A RAILWAY TO CONNECT WITH GRAND TRUNK PACIFIC WAS COLDLY TURNED DOWN BY M'BRIDE.

Yesterday we received through the mail a letter from Herbert L. Harris, a leading Liberal of Bella Coola, on the political situation there. We cut this same letter from the Victoria Times and printed it on Thursday, which shows the need of better mail facilities between this port and Bella Coola.

Being that these railways are only for the southern part of this province and will not be of any direct benefit to us in the north, it appears to me that we can lose nothing by our candidate coming out flatfooted and saying that he is prepared to do something for the northern part of British Columbia.

I may here mention that a Mr. Verschoyle, who has bought largely land at Bella Coola and is now surveying it up into town lots, with the idea that he would get some government assistance for a railway from this place to the Peace River country, through Fort Fraser or Fraser Lake, has of course now been refused any assistance for this project from McBride and his government.

For this reason lots of the Conservatives at Bella Coola are feeling sore and I would want that the Liberal candidate come out strong and say that he will do his utmost to obtain a reasonable bonus for a road from Bella Coola to connect with the Grand Trunk Pacific at Fort Fraser.

This very point cannot be too strongly used in this part of the district. Now at Ocean Falls, where there is quite a few voters, and that company has large holdings at or in the Bella Coola valley, the only thing that will appeal to them will be to come out and say that we will bonus a railway to Bella Coola, whether in government or opposition. If we get a Liberal government at this election, which I earnestly hope, we can well afford to do something.

The Ocean Falls people want a railroad by which to bring out

their logs and I believe that they are figuring on using this Bella Coola to Fraser Lake railway, and the only way that we can get their vote will be to put up a good proposition to them and they will do the rest.

Set your paper going on this point at once and have copies sent to Namu, Ocean Falls and Bella Coola and I am satisfied that we shall carry this election. Do not forget Rivers Inlet and Swanson Bay.

The northern part of this great province must be developed, and in order to do this we must start in at once. The Conservatives are making all sorts of bewildering and false statements.
