Editorial

THE DOMINATING FORCE

Almost every day we hear of raids on London, on the Thames estuary and on other British points but we hear little of the ships that continue to sail into and out of the port of London, almost daily, carrying food and munitions for the British and faking out manufactured goods with which to pay for the imports.

In spite of the fact that the Germans have guns mounted along the French coast and that German planes are ever ready to bounce on passing ships and bomb them or that submarines and torpedo boats shoot their deadly under-water weapons at the convoyed vessels, there are comparatively few casualties. Trade goes on in spite of the Germans. Sometimes German mines are laid along the routes taken but a mine sweeper precedes the convoy and insures safety from that source.

When you hear people tell of the pounding Britain is getting, do not fail to remind them of this sea trade that goes on day after day, week after week month after month, bringing not only necessities of life to the British but also many of the luxuries.

HITLER'S GUARANTEE
