Garner Claims Texas Leaguer

U. S. Vice-President Says He Started That Kind Of Play In Baseball

WASHINGTON, May 30: (CP)—Take it from Vice-President Jack Garner, a prominent Texan was the inventor of the Texas Leaguer in baseball—and his name was Jack Garner.

Garner, talking with Joe McCarthy, manager of the New York Yankees, explained in a recent meeting of the two famous figures: "When I was a young fellow I loved to play ball but I wasn't much of a hitter at first. I couldn't drive the ball very far and I wasn't fast enough to beat out infield hits. So I figured the best thing to do was just to tap the ball over the infield.

"I did that and it was very successful. All the young fellows around our town started doing it and finally it spread over the state and somebody started calling that kind of hit a Texas Leaguer."

It seems about five years ago Bing Crosby bought a horse—paid about \$5,000 for two-year old Khayyam. Khayyam never set the track afire but Khayyam was the little beginning of a great thing—Mr. Crosby, follower of the sport of kings. Brooklyn, however, holding top place mathematically. St. Louis Cardinals defeated Chicago Cubs and went into fifth place ahead of the Phillies who lost to Boston Bees.

In the American League Boston Red Sox continued in first place by defeating the Philadelphia Athletics while the running-up Cleveland Indians kept in pace by defeating Detroit Tigers.
