

Halibut landings at Prince Rupert yesterday totalled 98,500 pounds. American fares totalled \$4,000 pounds and prices were from 9c and 7.5c to 9.7c and 7.5c. Canadian fish amounted to 14,500 pounds for which 9.8c and 7c was paid.

The Vancouver-built fish packer Skeena Maid has arrived on the Skeena River. The vessel, built this summer, was launched a fortnight ago under the sponsorship of Mrs. Fred Nelson. She is powered with a 100-h.p. 5-cylinder Vivian plant and is owned by Cassiar Packing Co. Ltd. She made the

run to Prince Rupert at nine knots on 500 r. p. m., according to her engineer. This gives the craft a full speed of 10 knots on 600 r.p.m.

Having on board a total of 186 passengers, the large majority of whom were round trip tourists, C. P. R. steamer Princess Alice, Capt. Robert Thomson, arrived in port at 9:15 this morning from Vancouver and sailed a couple of hours later for Skagway and other Alaska points. Two persons disembarked from the vessel here while there were none taking passage from this port for the north.

**TERRACE PRODUCE**

Cauliflower, Cabbage and Beets Of Fine Quality Are Being Offered Here

Cauliflower, cabbage and beets of fine quality from Terrace are now being featured on the local retail produce market. A limited quantity of Terrace district strawberries is also being received here. Another interesting interior product now being offered here is Nechako Creamery butter from Vanderhoof, the quality of which is excellent and the price the lowest at which butter has ever been sold in Prince Rupert.

Seasonal fruits are also being featured on the local market. The season for canning cherries is about over. Apricots for canning are also coming in and the season will be short. British Columbia fruits are being hard hit by the long dry spell.

California fruits are much higher in price this year owing to the exchange of eleven percent and the new duty of ten percent. Notwithstanding this, the price of oranges just now is slightly lower. Egg prices have started their seasonal climb. Flour prices are somewhat weaker. The sugar price is firm.

W. F. Lindsay, who operated a general store in Terrace some years ago, has resumed business, having taken the new store building which has just been completed on Lakelse Avenue. The new building offers much greater convenience and scope than his old one and is a considerable improvement to the village.

The Cemetery Board waited on the village commissioners at the regular meeting of the commissioners on Wednesday. Chairman Harry King explained the object of their visit, which was in the hope of unravelling a difficulty in connection with the land titles. Title to the land used as the burial ground should be vested, it was felt, in some permanent body and the Cemetery Board, after full consideration, had decided to ask the corporation to assume ownership of the land in question.
