James McCullough, owner and regular skipper of the Dinamac, is now in the naval service and Gordon Williscroft, former Prince Rupert boy, is now the skipper with his father, W. E. Williscroft, as mate. Two others of the Williscroft boys-William and Frank-are at present in England with the Canadian Expeditionary Forces, Bill was in France before that nation withdrew from the war. The rest of the family are living in Vancouver.

Capt. Robert Thomson, southbound; next day. from Alaska to Vancouver, was in port from 4 o'clock to 5:30 yesterday afternoon. The present voyage was one of the finest on record in Alaska from a weather standpoint. There were 148 passengers aboard the Princess Alice. One person disembarked from the vessel at this port and eight took passage from here for Vancouver aboard her.

Aboard the steamer Prince Rupert, which was in port yesterday northbound from Vancouver to Skagway, was a capacity list of some two hundred passengers, most of them were round trip tourists. Only half a dozen disembarked here including a party of five soldiers.
