

War Work Is Being Done

The regular monthly meeting of Municipal Chapter, Imperial Daughters of the Empire, was held on Monday evening at the home of Mrs. C. A. Brind, with the regent, Mrs. H. L. Landry, in the chair.

Reports showed that, although all chapters are devoting a great deal of time to war work, they will provide clothing and gifts as usual for several isolated schools as well as their local Christmas cheer.

The convener of war work reported that the November shipment of comforts for all services included forty-one pairs of socks, twenty-eight sweaters, fifteen scarves, one hundred and five helmets, nineteen pairs of mittens, and six dozen handkerchiefs. There were also eleven pairs of pyjamas, eleven pairs of boys' stockings and a quilt for evacuees in Britain.

It is planned to send a small remembrance to local men who are in the Navy or overseas with the Canadian Active Service Force at Christmas time.
