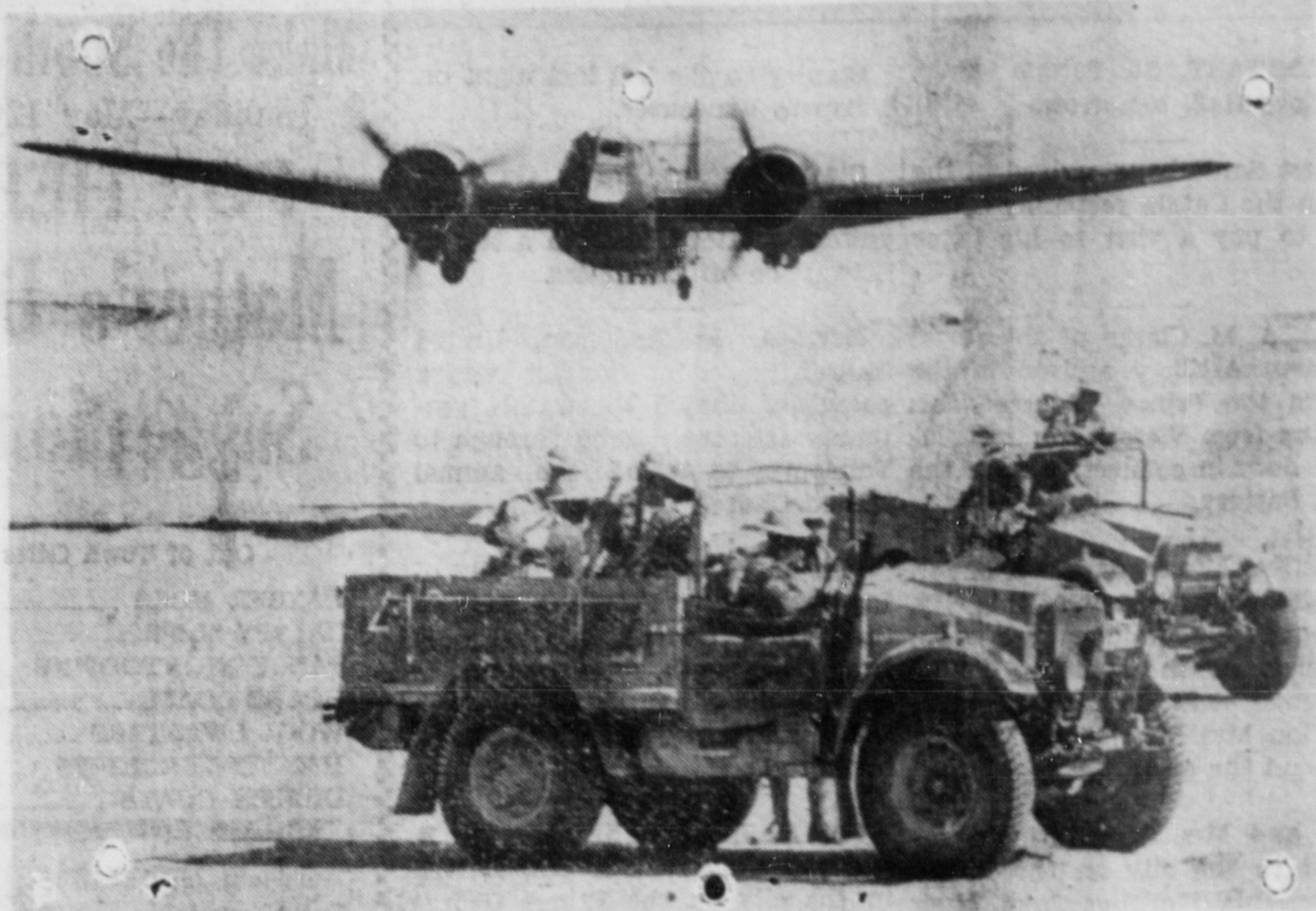

necessity and co-operation if the project was to materialize. G. L. Rorie was appointed to act on the community centre publicity committee with Robert Parker. Possible financial assistance by the Junior Chamber was discussed.

In view of the civic centre project, the suggestion was made that the Port Day might be abandoned this year in favor of a carnival it is planned to hold as a large effort to raise funds for the centre. George Rorie, J. C. Gilker and other members were, however, loath to drop the institution of Port Day although the suggestion was offered that it might possibly be held in connection with the carnival and the proceeds be applied also to the civic centre. After further discussion, a resolution was passed instructing the Port Day committee, consisting of J. C. Gilker, G. L. Rorie, E. G. Southby, John Connell and Stanley Saville, to formulate plans

for the holding of a Port Day this year.

The meeting was advised of resolutions to be brought up at a convention in Kelowna on May 24 and 25 of the Association of Junior Chambers of Commerce of British Columbia. One of these resolutions will urge the making a federal responsibility of construction, improvement and maintenance of trans-continental highways. Another will impress upon Junior Chambers of Commerce the importance of members welcoming tourists in their communities. Still another will make it clear that the Junior Chamber of Commerce of Canada is independent of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce. The local Chamber was asked to have a delegate at the Kelowna convention but it is unlikely that it will be able to be represented.

Ross Ingram reported that the recent "Clean Up and Paint Up" Week had been a success. Excellent support had been obtained and special mention was made of the

efforts of H. F. Pullen in connection with a special issue of the Daily News.

Best Way To Use Air Mail Service To And From East

A committee of the Prince Rupert Chamber of Commerce reported Monday night in regard to air mail services to and from the east making the following recommendations:

That air mail from the East, if mailed on Monday, Wednesday or Friday, be routed via Edmonton.

On Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday via Vancouver.

Air mail to the East by train to Edmonton Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

On Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday by boat as at present.

Under the present system, air mail from the East mailed on Monday, Wednesday and Friday takes 76 hours in transit and, as the train does not arrive until af-

ter business hours, air mail must be held over until the following day for delivery. To the above figure of 76 hours should be added 12 or a total of 88 hours.

On Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, mail has a holdover at Edmonton of an additional 24 hours, or a total of 112 hours. Under the proposed system air mail from the East mailed on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday will effect a saving in some cases of as much as 48 hours as some of the boats arrive during the business day.

The same remarks apply on air mail to the East.
