We have only to listen to the radio to know that. Much of it is insidious and not easily recognized as propaganda. When the American radio stations unduly dramatize the practical destruction of British cities it may be German propaganda. Every time we repeat the exaggerated reports of the German propaganda machine we aid Germany in her campaign of misrepresentation.
