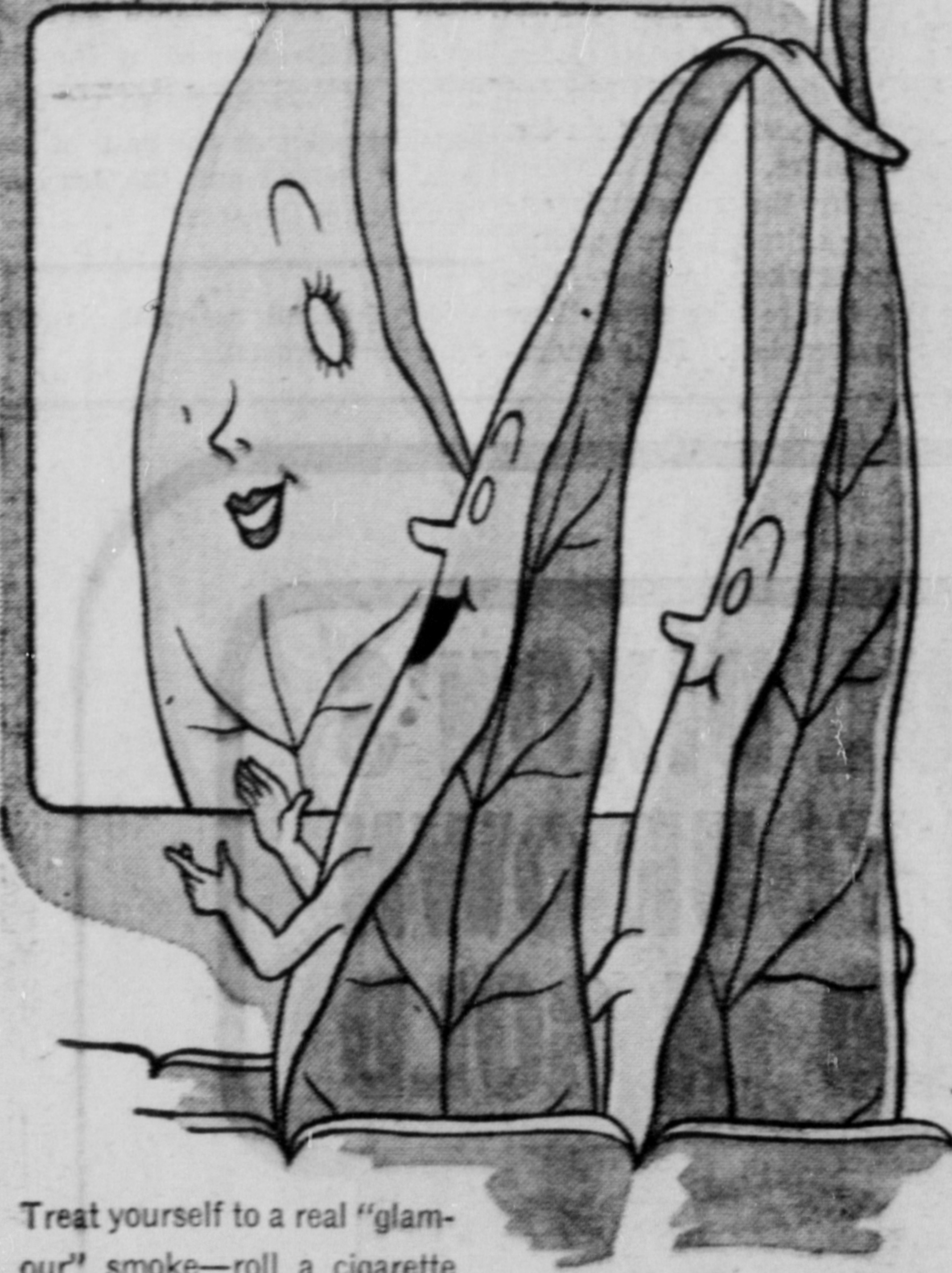
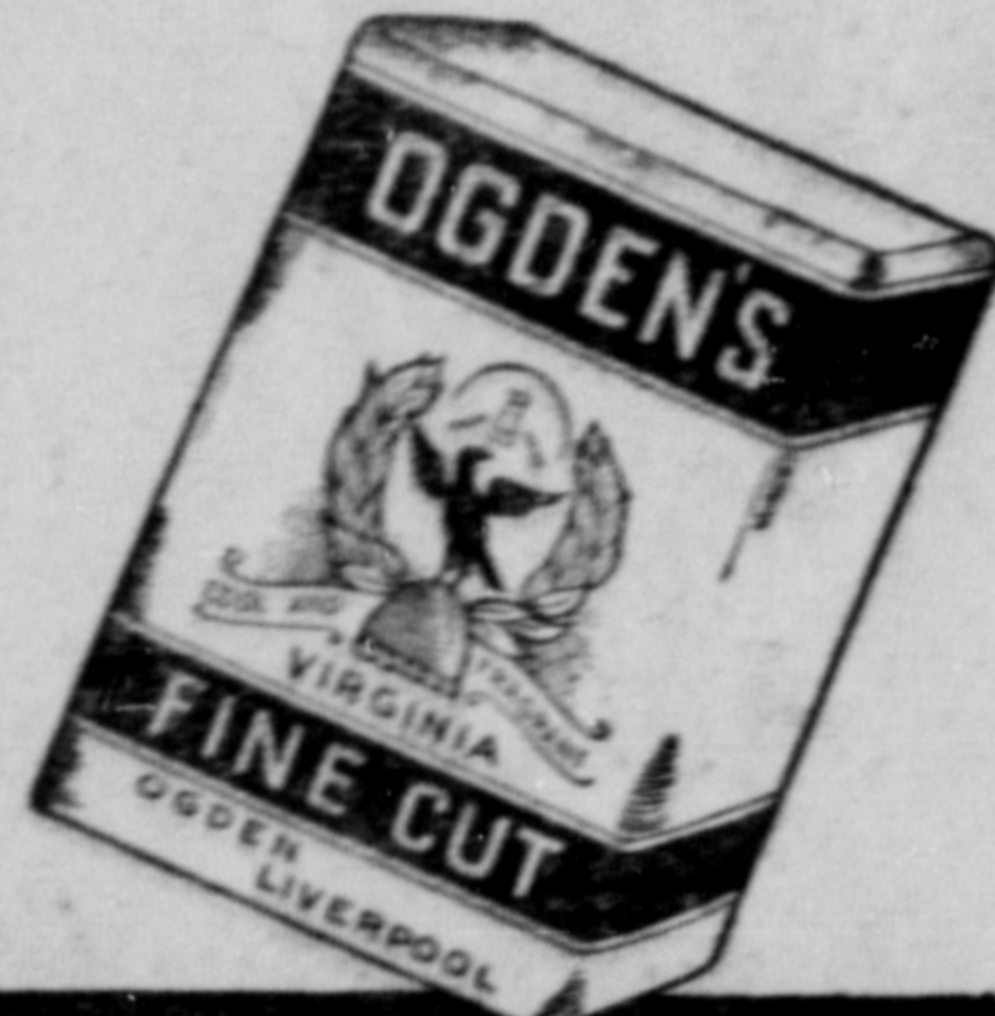

### Great Peaks Are Ascended

Fitzwilliam and Bucephalus Conquered By Climbers

JASPER PARK, Sept. 4.—Dominating peaks of the Yellowhead Pass, Mounts Fitzwilliam and Bucephalus both were ascended over the week-end by four Edmonton mountaineers who returned here yesterday.

From timberline camp near Lucerne, Reg Gault, skiing instructor from the Alpine Club of Canada, Dr. Hector MacLean and the Misses Jean MacDonald and Lillian Chapman made the ascent of Fitzwilliam in five hours. Sunday, climbing the neighboring Bucephalus in the afternoon.

First ascents of the two peaks, seldom climbed because of their inaccessibility, were made in 1917 by boundary commission engineers.
