


General Smuts Asks If Germany Failed To Stay Exodus From Dunkirk How Could They Expect To Win Now

CAPETOWN, July 22:- The veteran South African Prime Minister, General Jan Smuts, broadcasting a message to the Empire yesterday, was optimistic over the British winning the war against Germany and Italy. He said that, if the Germans were unable to stop the magnificent retreat from Dunkirk when they had the British forces trapped and at a decided disadvantage, how were they able to expect to win against an almost impregnable fortress. France had been lost owing to incredible mistakes on the part of the high command and as a result of political divisions. Britain was well led and the country was a unit in defending the country. It was futile to talk of defeat under such conditions. British sea power and air power were superior to the enemy. If Hitler lost in his attack on Britain he was defeated and if he failed to attack he was also defeated. His vast empire

From The Waterfront

Union steamer Catala, Capt. James Findlay, arrived in port at midnight last night from the south and sailed a couple of hours later for Stewart and other northern points whence she will return here tomorrow afternoon southbound.

The sockeye pack for Prince Rupert area up to July 13 totalled 30,665 cases as compared with 33,cases in the corresponding period last year. For the Naas River area the pack this year was 2,873 cases compared with 7,529 cases. Rivers and Smith's Inlet packs this season show substantial increases over a year ago and the total for the coast up to July 13 this season was 79,784 cases in comparison with 69,583 cases last year. The spring salmon pack for the skeena River this season has been 5,419 cases in comparison with 3,316 cases last year.

In port Saturday afternoon southbound frohm Skagway to Vancouver, C. P. R. steamer Princess Louise, Capt. S. K. Gray, had 203 passengers on board. Most of them were round trip Alaska tourists returning south. Two persons disembarked from the vessel at Prince Rupert and two went aboard at this port for Vancouver.

With a large list of passengers consisting principally of round trip tourists for Alaska, C.P.R. steamer Princess Alice, Cpt. Robert Thomson, arrived in port at 7:45 this morning from Vancouver, sailing at 10 a.m. for Skagway and other northern points. She is due back here Saturday afternoon southbound.


