

LAST 'NEXT' FOR 'LOUIE' Scatter Dogs But Save Them

British Woman Breeder Tells Of Efforts To Preserve Pedigreed Animals

NEW YORK, Oct. 17: (CP)—According to a letter from Miss D. W. Langston who lives in the southwest suburbs of air-raided London, pure-bred dog fanciers in the British Isles, despite all the blitzkriegs, intend to preserve the blood strains they have been improving for generations. The letter was written to Mrs. B. B. Cooley of Hillsboro, Oregon, and is published in the Kennel Gazette.

"All my young stock have been given away on breeding terms—scattered all over the British Isles with people who have sworn to stick to their dogs through thick and thin so I hope some may survive," says Miss Langston.

Many records of Miss Langston's kennels—photographs that cannot be replaced, books of pedigrees, and other notes on her Shetland shepherds—have been sent to the United States where she hopes they will be safe until she needs them again.

LOMBARD IN NURSE ROLE

"Vigil In The Night" Is Current Feature Picture On Screen Of Capitol Theatre

With the greater part of the stirring action taking place in two English hospitals during the months just preceding the current war, "Vigil in the Night" filmization of a sensational novel written by Dr. A. J. Cronin of "The Citadel" fame, is the feature picture at the Capitol Theatre here tonight and Friday. Carole Lombard, Brian Aherne and Anne Shirley have the stellar roles. Miss Lombard is a loyal nurse of high ideals. Aherne is a humanitarian doctor. Miss Shirley is a young student nurse. Miss Lombard's sister, who is temperamentally unsuited to the profession.

The story starts with the dismissal of Miss Lombard when she assumes the blame for her sister's negligence which resulted in the death of a child. In another town she joins a hospital which is insufficiently staffed and equipped. Here she meets Aherne who becomes interested in her when she saves him from losing a patient on the operating table. A feeling of understanding is born which lays the foundation for a romantic association. Meantime, the weaknesses of the sister are involving her in several disasters. The story reaches its climax in an isolation ward during an epidemic which is taking heavy toll of patients and nurses. The denouement is a heart-touching sacrifice which Miss Shirley makes to redeem herself.
