SKIDEGATE, Dec. 17: — Rev. Peter Kelly, with the United Church mission boat Thomas Crosby, made a trip to the Queen Charlotte Islands recently, accompanied by Mrs. Kelly who is first mate of the Crosby. They were given a very hearty welcome everywhere they went. Services were held at Sandspit, Skidegate, Skidegate Mission and Queen Charlotte and Mr. Kelly conducted baptisms and marriage ceremonies. There were also several public receptions.  
Very popular here, Mr. and Mrs. Kelly were asked to stay on the islands for Christmas, but Mr. Kelly told the people that he had a great deal of territory to cover with the missionary doctor on the mainland. This had to be looked after and there were also many small and isolated places, he explained, where the mission delivered mail and supplies. He would endeavour to return in the early part of the year, however, he said.  
Mrs. E. C. Stevens, sister of Mrs. Kelly, joined the Thomas Crosby here and crossed to Ocean Falls whence she is proceeding on a trip to Victoria.
