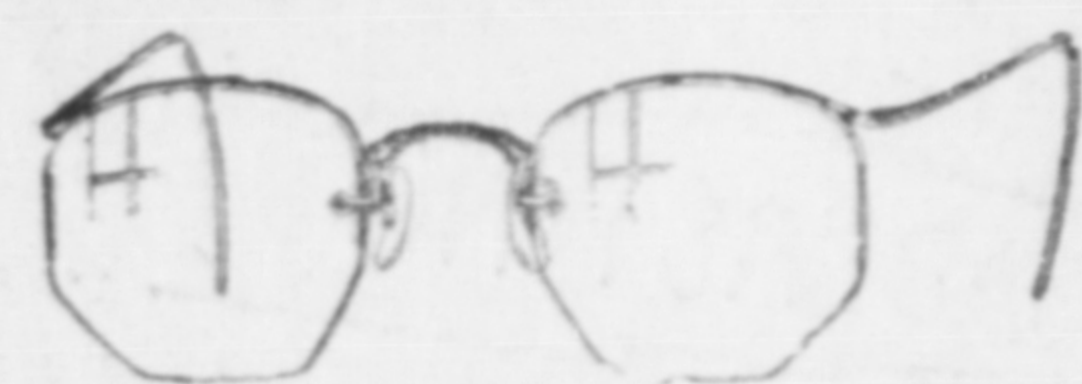

"The Invisible Woman," Odd Com-
edy, At Capitol Theatre This
Mid-Week

"The Invisible Woman," a novel comedy film featuring some amazing trick photography effects, is the mid-week feature picture at the Capitol Theatre this Wednesday and Thursday. Cast in the starring roles are Virginia Bruce, John Barrymore, John Howard, Charlie Ruggles and Oscar Homolka.

Barrymore portrays an eccentric scientist who invents a machine that renders human beings invisible. Miss Bruce is the attractive subject for his successful experiments. Howard enacts a wealthy playboy who finances the venture.

The machine also plays an important part in the picture's exciting climax when it is stolen from the laboratory by a henchman of a fugitive gangster, Oscar Homolka, who appears in the gangster role, seeks the strange device in order to render himself invisible for a visit to his old resorts. The eventual frustration of his schemes provides the story with an unusual dramatic situation.

The picture on this occasion is handled from the comedy rather than from the horror standpoint. Edward Brophy, Donald McBride, Margaret Hamilton and Thurston Hall have supporting roles.
