## Interesting Lecture

Following this O. C. Young of the Prince Rupert Fisheries Experimental Station gave a very interesting lecture entitled "Time and Space."

In dealing with "Time" Mr. Young stated that the earth was born out of the sun some two billion years ago as a globe of hot gas and gradually assumed a condition suited to life.

The first kind of life appears to have existed only in the water but gradually fishes changed to reptiles and reptiles to mammals and they, in their turn, into man. The first life probably appeared about 300 million years ago but man only appeared about 300 thousand years ago or 1-1000 of the time there has been life on the earth. There has possibly been 10,000 generations of human beings on the earth which, when compared with the age of the earth, is only a twinkling of the eye.

In discussing "Space" the lecturer spoke of the distance around the earth which is 25,000 miles but this, as compared with the 93 million miles from the earth to the sun, is only a step and earthly distances shrink to nothing when thinking of solar system distances.

The solar system is only one tiny system within a galaxy of systems in which the earth's little system almost disappears. This galaxy of systems is called the galactic system. Distances in it are beyond imagination and can only be measured by the unit called the light year.

A light year is the distance light will travel in one year. Light travels 186,000 miles in one second. The distance from the earth to the sun is about 81-3 minutes. The distance around the earth is 24,000 miles and this is about 1-7 of a light second.

If, in imagination, one got into a space ship travelling at the speed of light the globe could be circled seven times in one second. At this

speed it would take 81-3 minutes to get to the sun. On this journey two planets would have been passed—Venus first and then Mercury. By using the space ship travelling at the speed of light the lecturer gave his audience some idea of distances on the heavens above them and that the span of a human life was not long enough in which to visit the more distant stars.

# Timely Recipes

## SCALLOPED POTATOES WITH HAM

4 to 6 potatoes — depending on size.  
2 tablespoons butter.  
1 tablespoon minced onion.  
Milk.  
Salt and pepper.  
Peel potatoes and cut into thin slices. Arrange in thick layers in buttered baking dish or casserole. Dot each layer with butter, some of the minced onion, and salt and pepper. When dish is about full, pour over top enough milk (about 2 cups) to reach top layer of potatoes. Cover with thin slice of uncooked ham or slices of bacon. Bake, covered, in moderate oven (350 deg. F.), for 30 minutes. Remove cover and continue baking from 1/4 to 1 hour longer, or until ham and potatoes are tender. Serves 6.


