Long Article on Natural Resources of Northern British Columbia Published in Financial Paper of Brussels.

U. S. COAL MATTERS

Coal Operators and Miners Sign New Wage Scale.

Indianapolis, Ind., May 6.—Representatives of soft coal mine owners of Ohio, Western Pennsylvania, Illinois and Indiana and of the United Mine Workers of America, of those states, this afternoon signed the wage agreement ratified by the recent referendum vote of the miners. The agreement will be the basis of contracts to be entered into for the next two years by the bituminous miners and operators of many states. It grants a wage increase of 5 cents a ton.
