**RED CROSS SHIPMENT**

**Waterfront Whiffs**

Herring Season is Looking More and More Like Failure—Next Thing Will be Commencement of Halibut Fishing

Although hope has not been entirely given up as yet for the development of a belated run, prospects for this winter's herring fishery around Prince Rupert are now far from bright. With no appreciable run having yet appeared in spite of widespread search for the fish in seining quantities it is beginning to look now like an almost complete failure. In any case, should fish appear now they would probably be poor with spawn and not in very good shape either for canning or reduction purposes. Failure of the run would also be serious for the halibut fishery which depends on herring for bait. Of course, it is possible that the summer herring might relieve this situation to some extent. Unless the fish show up within the next week it is likely that the seineboats will commence withdrawing and the processing plants abandon hope of getting a supply.
