EDITORIAL

Follow The Torch . . .

Prince Rupert has sent a torch to Great Britain promising that she will do her part in providing the sinews of war for the present year. Next week canvassers will be out taking applications for Victory bonds designed to provide the money with which to pay for the building of ships, airplanes, tanks and ammunition and quantities of other war material and food for the use of the people in Britain and for the Canadian army, navy and air force.

This week all those who have money in savings banks and current accounts are asked to consider carefully how much they can possibly devote to purchase of bonds. On these bonds the government will pay twice as much interest as the banks are paying and, if it becomes necessary to raise money at any time, the bonds can be sold on the market or used as bank collateral.

Most people will be anxious to help the cause in such an easy way. They will buy to the limit. Some few will try to find excuses why they should keep the money in the bank.

Sinking Of H.M.S. Hood . . .

While the sinking of the battle cruiser Hood will prove to be a loss to the British navy the sinking of the vessel in waters contingent to the American continent is likely to help arouse the American people to the dangers of the present situation. If Germans can send their warships into American waters in such a time as this what may they not do if their present opposition is absent?

We are not suggesting that there will come a time when there will be no European opposition to Germany. We believe that the American nation will steadily increase its support to the allied cause until it eventually goes all out against Hitler. We have no idea that we shall lose this war. We believe we shall win and probably within a year from now. All we suggest is that the sinking of the Hood will prove to be one of the strongest arguments in favor of United States help to Britain.

bridesmaids, but nobody seems to mind.

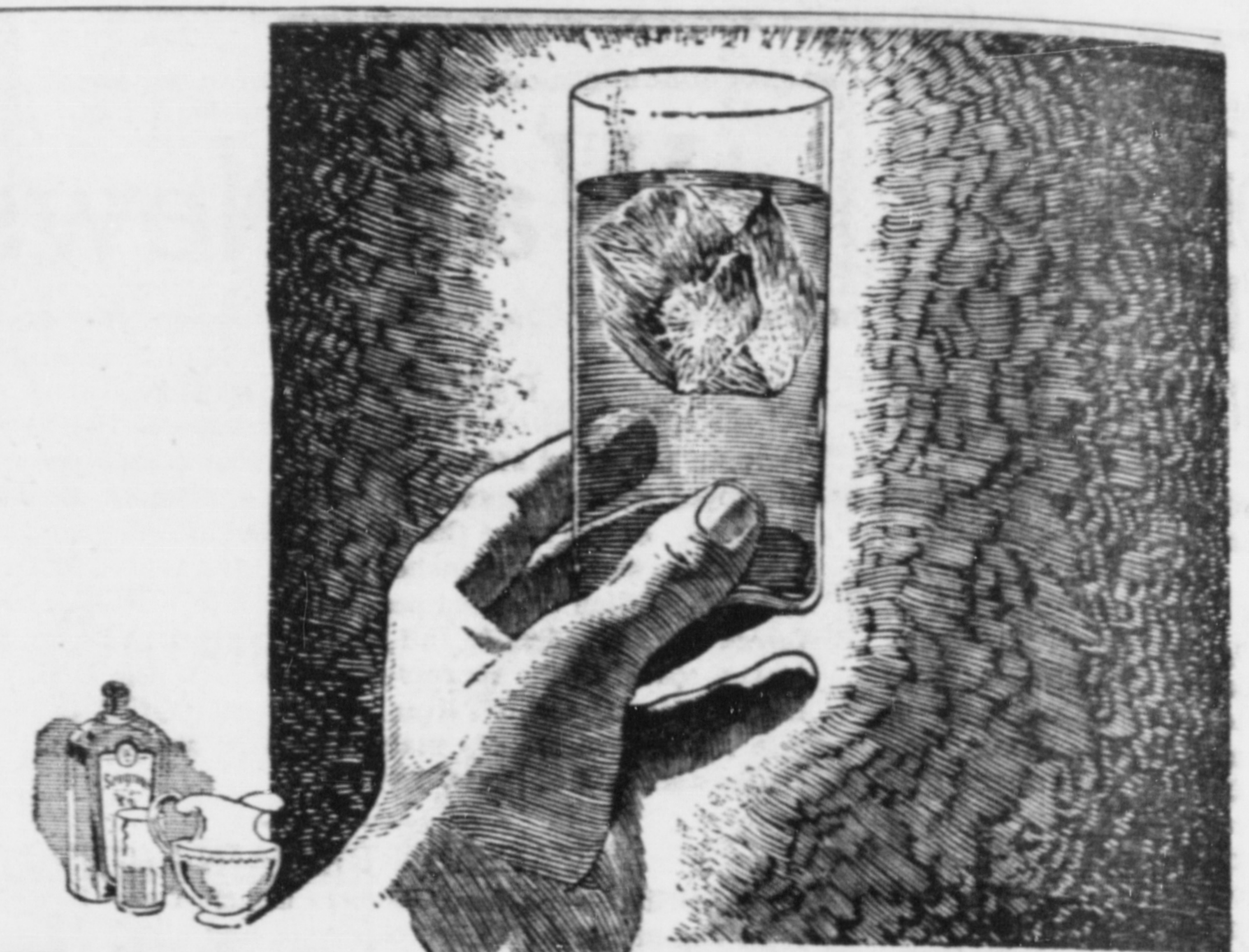
