LADYSMITH

Crazed Husband After Separation from Young Wife Returns to Shoot Her and Attempts the Life of His Own Child.

(Special to Daily News.) Ladysmith, May 30-The town was thrown into a frenzy of excitement last night at eleven o'clock by an attempted triple murder and suicide. The perpetrator of the deed, Joseph Allsoph, has been married less than two years, but was separated from his young wife. Allsoph returned from Vancouver tonight, and immediately went to the home of his mother-in-law, and fired two bullets at the breast of his wife then at Mrs. Hutchinson, and at his own baby. He missed the latter, but then fired two shots into his own body. The assassin will die, also his wife. Allsoph, who is believed to be insane, attempted suicide two months ago.
