British Typists Have Hard Tests

Have To Have What It Takes To Get Proficiency Bonuses

LONDON, June 23 (C)—Twenty-one thousand government typists lost £5,250 (about \$23,625) among them because they failed to pass a typing test. Only 4,000 of 25,000 entrants passed the test, qualifying them for five shillings a week proficiency pay. Those who failed forfeited a five-shilling entrance fee.

PLAIN OMELET

For each egg add one tablespoon top milk, 1/2 teaspoon salt and pepper if desired. Beat eggs slightly. Beat in milk and seasoning. Heat one tablespoon dripping in frying pan. APPLICATION CARDS FOR COUPON RATIONING OF SUGAR

are being mailed this week to every Household in Canada

Canadians will be required to register so that ration cards, good for the 10 week period, commencing July 1st, may be issued immediately. At the end of that period a coupon ration book, good for six months, will be issued.

HOW TO REGISTER

Residents in Urban Areas not served by Letter Carrier, and Residents in Rural Areas

Application cards will be distributed to all householders through the post offices on or before Tuesday, June 23rd. Additional cards will also be delivered for every person resident in the household, who bears a different last name from the head of the household. If needed, extra cards may be secured from local post offices. You will fill in a card complete in every detail. A pamphlet giving complete instructions will be delivered with each card.

During the evening of June 25th, an authorized representative of The Wartime Prices and Trade Board will call at your home and collect the card. As soon as your name is duly registered at headquarters, ration cards good for a ten-week period, will be mailed to you—one ration card for each person in your home. These will be for sugar only. If there are any details of the application card you do not quite understand, the representative of this Board will help you to fill it in on June 25th, when he or she calls to pick it up.

COUPON RATIONING FOR SUGAR BECOMES EFFECTIVE JULY 1st

Beginning July 1st, no one will be permitted to buy sugar for regular domestic use without a ration coupon. Prompt co-operation on the part of the public in filling out and returning their application cards is necessary to ensure return of the ration coupon card in time to purchase sugar on or after the above date. Remember—the amount of sugar allowed each individual under the new coupon rationing plan will be exactly the same as allowed at present—1/2 pound per person per week. The provision for additional sugar for preserving, etc., will be continued. Special voucher forms for this purpose are being supplied to all retailers. No person may have on hand more than two weeks' supply of sugar, unless resident in a remote district.
