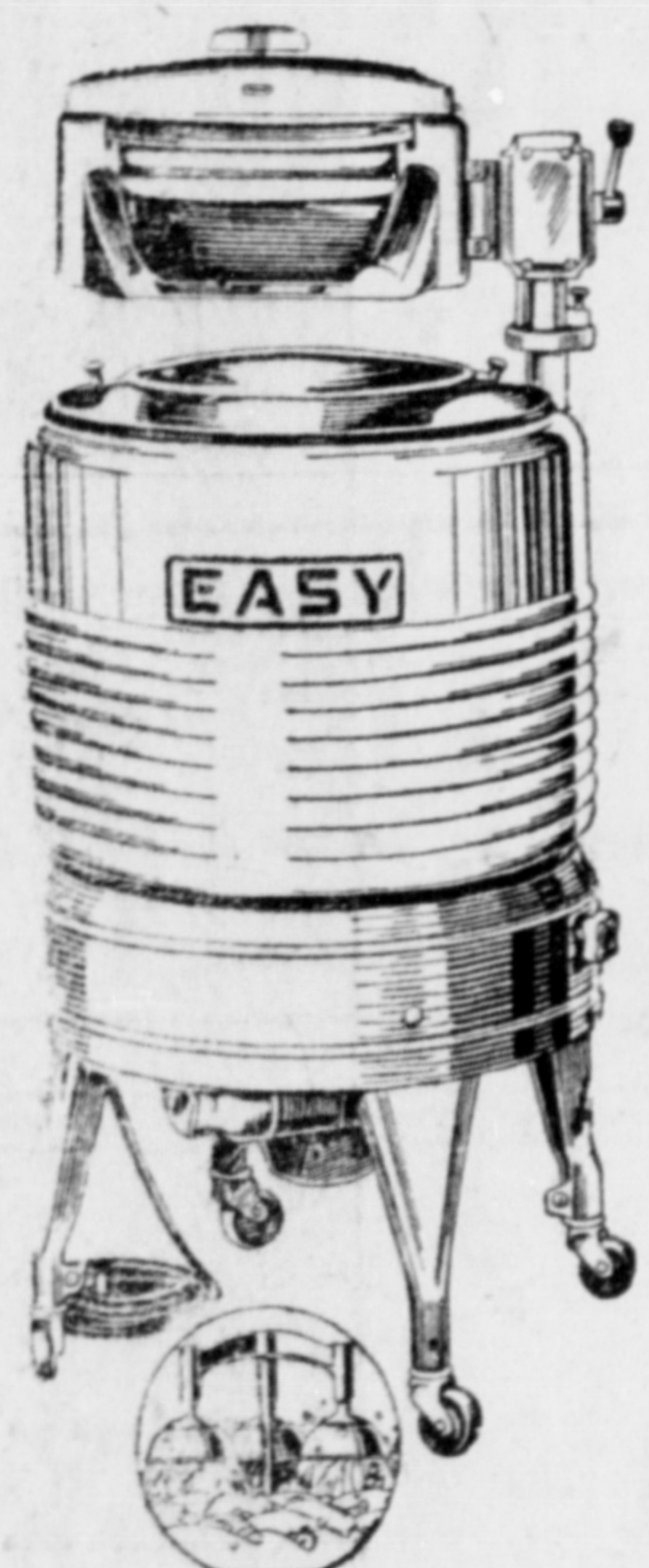

## Little Is Again Club President

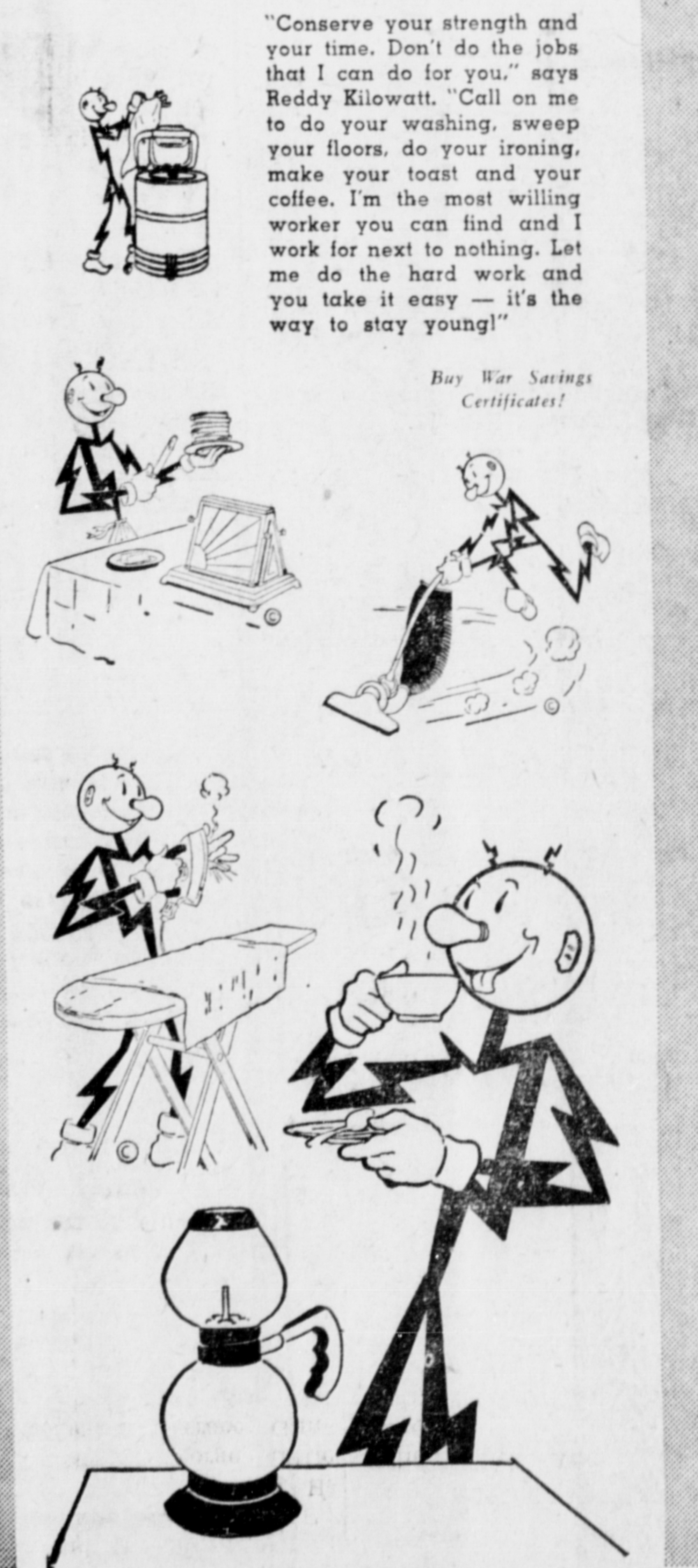
