the growing part that women were taking in the war—the nursing services, the army corps some of whom were on active service overseas, the women's naval service, the air force. He referred to the work of women in munitions making and on the farms, doing jobs that were formerly done by men. Women were, indeed, doing their part in helping to preserve the nation.

The Enemy's Intentions

Those people whose country had not been invaded, said the Prime Minister in opening, still might find it difficult to realize the magnitude or the monstrosity of Nazi intentions. Possibly only the victims of invasion could fully appreciate the real issues. That war today threatened the freedom of mankind must be obvious to all. There were those who spoke of a benevolent dictatorship but a world ruled by a tyrant who was the incarnation of evil would be an unmitigated curse. That would be the fate of the world if the Axis were to triumph in this war. The Satanic power of the enemy was indicated by horrors, brutalities and atrocities which were reported daily. The Nazi aim was nothing short of the total destruction of Christian civilization. Hitler, who had said that he who kindled war in Europe would bring nothing but chaos, true to his word, had contributed nothing but chaos to the world. It had been said that deeds of today were like those of the Dark Ages. Never before, however, had a nominally civilized and Christian nation descended to such depths of darkness. A deformed monstrosity had crawled out of the darkness and was challenging the world for possession of its soul.

If Germany should win this war it would mean the destruction of the free spirit of man. Not merely was the intention of the enemy the conquest of territory and world domination but he sought to possess the soul of the world and to destroy the very spirit of free man. These things would be accomplished unless the enemy was utterly and completely destroyed. No man could escape the consequences of this war, declared the Prime Minister — bondage on the

one hand or a new era of justice and security on the other. Every man must make the utmost contribution to ensure the defeat of the enemy and the triumph of the righteous cause. Not merely must conquest by barbarians of this land be prevented but it must be ensured that good and not evil be exalted for generations to come. Those who sacrificed their lives today, and Canadians had been among these, were part of the chivalry of the Gods.

In passing, the Prime Minister referred to the recent arrival in Canada of a party of airmen who only twenty-two hours previous had been engaged in bombing of enemy objectives in western Europe. This was an illustration of how the vastness and nearness of existing danger was to be measured in hours instead of days.

The Prime Minister paid tribute to the great part that Russia and China were playing in this war of liberation. Had it not been for the long resistance of the Chinese, Australia and New Zealand would have been in a much more serious position today. Had it not been for the Russian resistance Canadians might be fighting for their lives on their own coasts.

Germans, Italians and Japanese still believed in their ability to conquer the whole world. Never had it occurred to them that their leaders or their cause might be wrong.

No one could say after three years how long the war might last, said Mr. King. The utmost effort of each individual was essential.

The Prime Minister referred to the growth of the Canadian navy since the start of the war to its present strength of 400 ships and 40,000 men. He also paid tribute to the exploits of Canadian airmen.

Canada among the nations of the world was first in the field of supplies, was foremost in equitable taxation and had led in control of the cost of living and manpower.

Canadian production could never be limited to the needs of her own forces. In 1940, for instance, Great Britain had been saved by the delivery of wheat and food.

Until the forces of evil as represented by the enemy were completely destroyed there could be no peace in the world, declared the Prime Minister in closing.

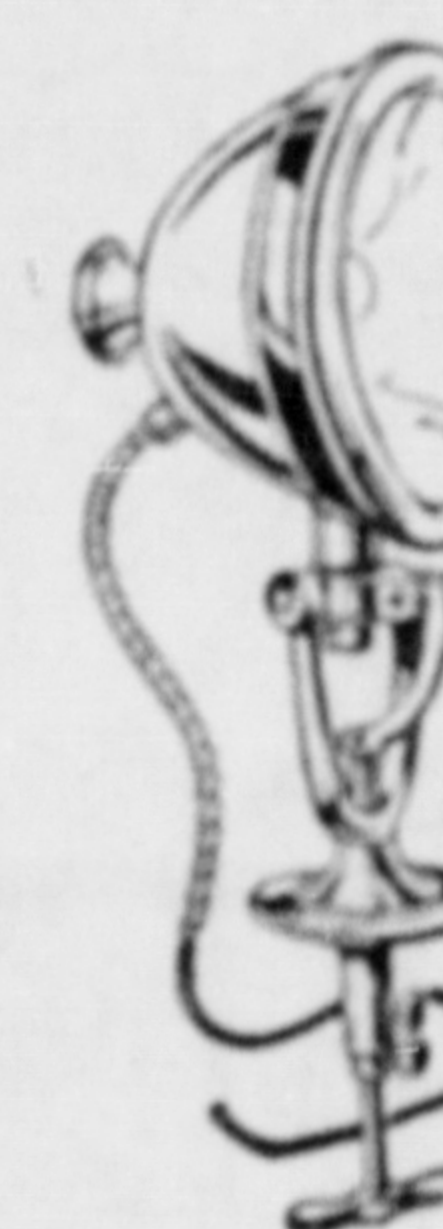
