**Waterfront Whiffs**  
 Talk of Lifting Halibut Restrictions This  
 Year — Fisheries Experimental  
 Station in New Vancouver  
 Home

There is unofficial talk of the halibut fishing season on the Pacific coast opening this year in February, two months earlier than usual. There is also a move, it is said, to lift the fishing quotas this year and permit fishing without restriction. There would, however, be strong opposition to this in certain quarters and it is considered unlikely that such a drastic change in policy would be permitted now after so many years and so much money and effort has been expended towards the conserving of the fishery. It should be emphasized that there is no official foundation for such discussion. No announcement has yet been made in regard to 1943 halibut regulations.

Dr. Neal Carter, director of the fisheries experimental station, formerly situated here and moved last year to Vancouver, left Vancouver last week for Ottawa to attend the annual meeting of the Fisheries Research Board of Canada. John Dybban of this city is attending the same meeting.

The Pacific Fisheries Experimental Station, formerly situated here and moved a few months ago to Vancouver because of being crowded off the local waterfront by the navy, has now opened up in its permanent new quarters in a building on Richards Street at the corner of Smythe Street in Vancouver. The premises, formerly occupied by the Coca Cola Company, underwent considerable alterations and renovation before being taken over by the station. Pending the obtaining of this location, the station staff and some of the equipment had been set up in temporary quarters in the University of British Columbia area.

Dr. H. N. Brocklesby, formerly in charge of the chemistry department of the Pacific Fisheries Experimental Station, and Mrs. Brocklesby and family are now established in the San Francisco area where Dr. Brocklesby has taken an important executive position with a commercial fisheries concern.
