Clocks Scarce in Australia and Men Have to be at Work On Time

SYDNEY, N.S.W., July 21 ()-Many Sydney women have to stay awake half the night to make sure their husbands get up in time for work because of acute shortage of alarm

More than 25,000 alarm clocks could be sold immediately in available, a city jeweler said quiries daily for alarm clocks of all kinds-many from wives wanting to end their early morning vigil.




