Thinning those of carrots, lettuce and such

it is difficult to space evenly and thinly but with a little care one can prevent bunching. This care in sowing will be repaid later when the plants start to grow, as much thinning will be saved.

But even with this careful sowing, some thinning is inevitable with beets, onions, parsnips and similar fine seed plants. The object s to give room for early growth. It is not necessary to thin, say, beets and carrots, to more than an inch or so apart. Long before they have reached full maturity a lot of the beets and carrots will have been pulled and used. When the plants are half grown one can start using every other one in the row.

Importance of Cultivation

Killing weeds is only one function of cultivation. In the well cared for garden where weeds never
