REFRIGERATOR RELAXING?

Your Electric Refrigerator must last for the duration. Help it to do the best job possible by giving it a little care. You'll save serious trouble later and you'll get much better all-round performance. Here's how to keep it running:

- Defrost according to manufacturer's instructions. Empty the drip water immediately.
- Wash the inside of your refrigerator with baking soda and water each time the refrigerator is defrosted. Don't forget the freezer — that's where food odors collect. • Avoid overloading the refrigerator with food — it stops
- necessary air circulation. • Be sure the cold control is set as it should be to give the proper food compartment temperature.
