## Timely Recipes

PEAR MARMALADE 4 lbs. peeled, cored, sliced

pears (about 15) 2 ounces green ginger root or 1 ounce dry ginger root (optional)

3 lemons 3 lb. sugar

Place pears in preserving ketonto and was the guest speaker tle in layers, sprinkling each layer with sugar, lemon juice grated green ginger. If

dried ginger root is used, break in pieces and tie in a bag. Let stand 2 to 3 hours. Cook slowly until thick and clear. Pour into hot sterilized jars, cool, wax and cover.
