
Described as the most ambitious historical document in motion picture form evoked by the war, covering as it does the whole of the victorious British army campaign against Marshal Erwin Rommel's Axis forces from the retirement to El Alamein to the rout through Libya, Cryenaica and Tripoltania into Tunisia, "Desert Victory," largely of war documentary nature but also with some dramatic effects, is to be presentthis Thursday, Friday and Satured at the Capitol Theatre here day. Events in the North African campaign having only a few days ago reached their climax and with pride still swelling in the hearts of all Britishers as the feats of General Montgomery's gallant Eighth Army are considered, this is a picture which few people will want to miss.
