- 3 tablespoons shopped onion 1-3 cup chopped celery tablespoons fat
- 1½ cups corn—(3 medium cobs)
- 2 teaspoons salt 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1½ teaspoons sugar
- 3 cups scalded milk 1-3 cup wacker crumbs


