

Cabbage is for Kings!



Full of Vitamin C, Cabbage has come into its own as a favourite food

First a word to the wise about cooking cabbage as a green vegetable. It will have better texture, colour and flavour (and more vitamins) if you cook it quickly in boiling water (seven minutes shredded, a little longer in sections).

But don't be content only to serve it like that . . . or as cole slaw though cole slaw is nutritionally valuable. But there are so many other good ways of enjoying cabbage. For

CABBAGE ROLLS to Serve 4

16 lb. ground beef 2 tbsps. chopped 8 large cabbage 2 theps. fat 1 cup cooked rice 1 cup cooked (or bread tomatoes crumbs) 14 cup sliced onion 1 egg, slightly 1/2 bay leaf

Salt and pepper 16 cup milk Parboil cabbage leaves 5 minutes.

Combine beef, rice, egg, milk, seaoning and 2 thsps. onion. Place a

spoonful of meat mixture in each leaf and fold to cover meat; fasten with toothpicks. Brown in fat in large pan. Add tomatoes, sliced onion and bay leaf; cover and simmer 45 minutes.

SPICY CABBAGE AND

1/2 lb. sausage 1 cup canned toma-1 tsp. vinegar toes, or gravy 1.tsp. paprika 6 soda crackers 2 cups shredded (crumbled) raw cabbage

Crumble sausages and panfry. Mix in vinegar, paprika and cracker crumbs. Place layer of cabbage in casserole, then layer of sausage mixture. Repeat. Add tomatoes or stock. Bake, covered, in moderate oven (350°) about 30 minutes.
