Waterfront Whiffs

Now the fish are low on account of the cold and it would be impossible, anyway, to cast nets for they would soon freeze. There have been signs of herring for some time around Khutzamateen and elsewhere. Meantime, the seiners and the packers are all in port but will be heading out as soon as the weather changes.
