**Waterfront Whiffs**

Big Money in Halibut These Days —  
 Prices Drop Off Somewhat Today—  
 Spring Salmon Dribbling In

Fourteen Canadian halibut boats have landed catches at Prince Rupert during the ten days following the opening of the 1943 fishing season on April 15. Prices went up to the highest level in the history of the port reaching a peak of 30.5c and 25 on Thursday. The previous record high price had been 27c some fifteen years ago. The prices showed a falling off today. These high prices meant heavy shares for the fishermen, running in some cases to well over \$200 for trips of a week or ten days. Up to today no American vessels had been in with catches but the coming week, it is expected, will see their arrivals with heavy landings all around.
