

BABES PICK THEIR FOOD

Are Perfectly Able to Feed Themselves After First Few Months

KNYSNA, South Africa (P-In the shadow of the yellowwood and stinkwood giants of Cape Province's famous Knysna forests, a young South African doctor is attracting the attention the medical world abroad. He Dr. W. Harding le Riche, medial officer in charge of the Knyna Health Centre, which looks the cutters who work deep n the forest glades.

Dr. le Riche is extending the experiments made in the United States by Dr. Clara M. Davis. Both have reached the conclusion that newly-weaned babies, from five months old upwards, are perfectly able to select their own foods in such quantities and of such a variety as to maintain themselves in perfect health..

The experiments allow babies o pick exactly what they want, vithout any interference or persuasion from adults. The foods are not prepared in any way except for cutting where necessary into manageable portions. In only a few cases are they cooked, but apart from that they are absolutely untouched, unpurified and unseasoned. They nclude ordinary meats, liver, kidneys, fish, a wide selection of vegetables, fruits, eggs, milk, cereals and other materials.


