



CITY MAY TAKE CHLORINATOR AS SAFEGUARD

The army chlorinating plant installed here as a wartime health safety measure and still being operated by the Army, probably will be taken over by the city if an acceptable basis for negotiations can be reached between council and the Defence Derartment.

Although the chlorinator has met been declared surplus. chase, concluding that they would take it over on a similar basis to that under which Vanouver acquired its chlorinating plant recently.

Vancouver's \$85,000 plant was acquired for \$11,000 or 13 per ent of its initial cost. On the same basis, Prince Rupert's \$12,-000 plant would be available to the city for \$1,600.

ELACKPOOL, Eng., (9)-Britons seend annually on drink alone 12 times the total of their yearly fuel and light bills, a conference of electrical engineers here was told.

R. S. Thwaites, manager of Manchester's electricity department, also said that tobacco cost the average British family | 1 10 times their light and fuel bills. Nathonal expenditure in Greet Pritain last year on fuel and light was £265,000,000 (\$1,-192.500,000) whereas £548.000,000 was raid out for tobacco and £685,000,000 for drink.




