SATURDAY SERMON

THE BIBLE TRUTH

Your faith should not stand in the wisdom but in the power of God" (Inst. Cor. 2:5), we like to draw attention to a few discrepancies in tradition and Truth.

Let us note that God does invite us to use our own reason together, saith the Lord.

The Bible does not say many other things it is charged with, for instance, the Bible does not say there were "three wise men" nor that they followed the star from the East; nor that they ever visited Bethlehem; nor that they found the Babe in a manger; or even in a stable; nor that the "angels sang" Glory to God in the highest.

Again Romans 7:2 does not say or suggest that the law forbade the divorcement of a woman, (though New Testament teaching does not permit a Christian to separate from his, or her, mate, even though the marriage is "common law").

The Bible does not say "money is the root of all evil." It says "the love of money," ah yes, "out of the heart are the issues of life" "the heart is deceitful above all things (deceiving your own selves), and desperately wicked, who can know it? I the Lord search the heart." "Come unto me and I will give you rest," "I will give you a new heart wherein dwelleth righteousness." "Whatever will may come."

Then we are asked, "how Cain could go to the land of Nod and get a wife if Adam and Eve were the only people on earth?" Well, the Bible doesn't say he got a wife in the land of Nod but it does say "... and the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years and he begat sons and daughters." Surely Cain could pick a wife out of that lot. That is Gen. 5:5. Just read those four chapters for yourself and notice just what it says.
