Final Rites Held for Former Volunteer and Prominent Member of Moose Lodge

Old friends gathered at the Grenville Court chapel of the B.C. Undertakers yesterday afternoon to pay final respects to the memory of the late Benjamin M. Simpson, who died suddenly during the week. Among those in attendance at the funeral rites were members of the Moose Lodge of which deceased had been a prominent member for many years.

S. T. Jacobsen of Saskatoon, who is relieving here as pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, officiated and Mrs. J. C. Gilker presided at the organ as accompanist for hymns which were "Abide With Me" and "O For a Faith."

After the service, interment was made in Fairview Cemetery. Pallbearers were Harold Hampton, N. I. Jones, Hans Gieke, Gilbert Rower, Joseph Slaggard and Fred Gooden.

The late Mr. Simpson was born near Bergen, Norway, in 1867 and came to America as a young man. First in the Yukon in Gold Rush days and came here from Dawson.
