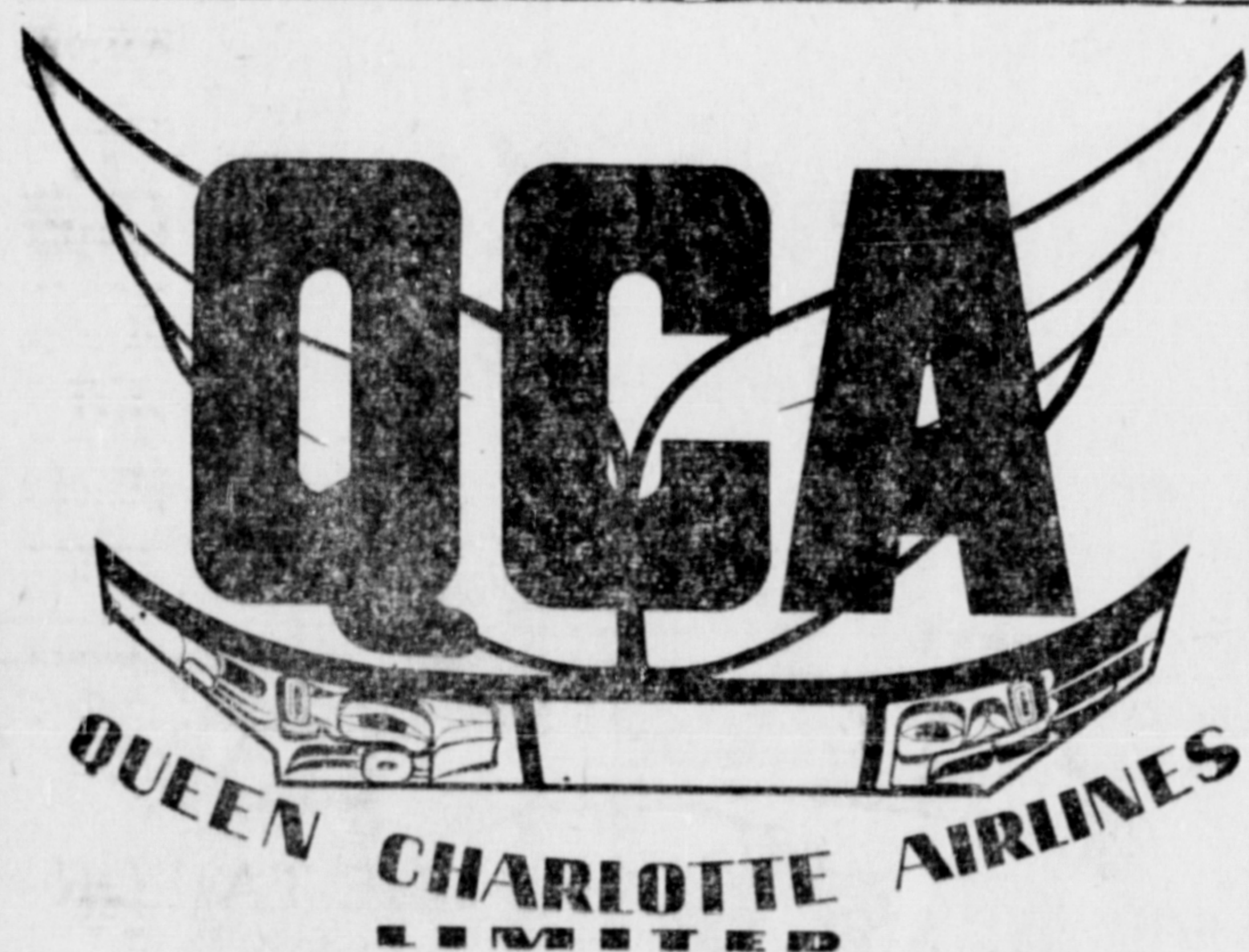

NOMAD CHILDREN ENJOY CLASSES

Australia Teaches Youngsters Of Wandering Aborigines

ERNABELLA, South Australia — A school for children of wandering Aborigines is conducted in this little settlement, 400 miles north of Adelaide, by Ernest Trudinger, an Australian fluent in the native dialects.

Instruction is given in the Aboriginal tongues by Trudinger who teaches writing, arithmetic, drawing and singing, elementary carpentry and gardening.

Classes, supported by the state government of South Australia, are held for whatever children happen to be at Ernabella with their nomad parents.

Their instruction varies according to their ages, and on the average there are five classes of five pupils each week. Trudinger does most of the teaching but sometimes leaves classes of the smaller children in the care of his older and more apt pupils.

He says favorite subjects with the children are drawing and singing. When they sing, they are so naturally sensitive to pitch, rarely is any one of them out of tune.

As a return for his teaching, Trudinger has picked a fund of information from the children about birds, animals and bushcraft.

MAY PRODUCE PERSIAN LAMB

SYDNEY, Australia — Persian lamb, one of the luxuries of the fur trade, may soon be produced in Australia, according to experts investigating the possibility of introducing the karakul into this country. Persian lamb is a fashion favorite with Australian women, and karakul, from which the pelts are obtained, thrive in semi-desert country. Sponsors of the new project claim that the animal, a cross between a sheep and a goat, would flourish on many waste areas of the Northern Territory, thus making those areas productive. Interior Minister Johnson has decided to consider a definite plan for putting the scheme into operation. Promoters are considering importing stud stock from South Africa, Persia or France, and are prepared to spend substantial sums if suitable land can be secured. Meanwhile, feminine hopes run high.

Flights to Japan Keep Airmen Busy

AUCKLAND, N.Z. — Nearly 250,000 miles have been flown by No. 41 Squadron, Royal New Zealand Air Force, since March in maintaining the only direct link between New Zealand and the Dominion's occupation force in Japan. In spite of exceedingly unstable weather which prevails over this route, a difficult one for flying, the squadron has had to jettison only one mail load. Several typhoons have been encountered, necessitating the diversion of the aircraft to landing places far off their course. The normal route has been from Auckland, New Zealand, to Norfolk Island, Brisbane, Cloncurry and Darwin, in northern Australia, and the islands of Morotai, Laoag and Okinawa, to Kanoya, in Japan. The squadron's Dakotas have carried 15,000 pounds in passenger weight, 65,000 pounds of mail and 14,000 pounds of freight.

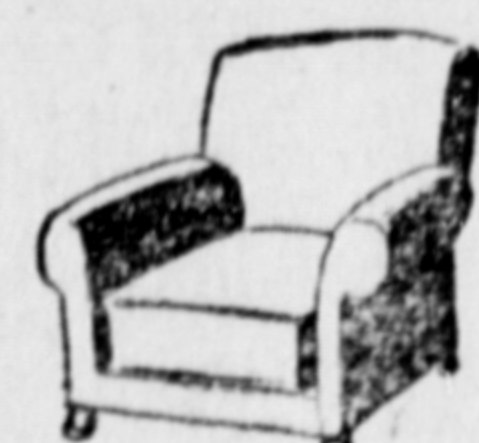
