



ALASKA WANTS HARD SURFACED

TERRACE-The Terrace and District Board of Trade will present a resolution at the annual convention of the Associated Boards of Trade here next week "practically demanding" that the northern transprovincial highway be hard surfaced immediately, George McAdams, vice-president of the Associated Boards of Trade, said here last coffeee cost nearly \$30 a pound.

"Our resolution is not so far fetched as it might seem," he declared at the organizing meeting, opera singers when they hit high rushed from London of the Terrace branch of the B.C. C.
