**SAVOY DOWNS RAINMAKERS**

**Kitkatla Comes to Town And Loses by Single Point**

A powerful Savoy squad downed the Bo-Me-Hi Rainmakers in a one-sided affair last night at the Civic Centre by a score of 55 to 32. The game was never in doubt with Savoys having their own way for most of the time. Only in the second quarter did the Rainmakers come close and in that quarter both teams got 14 points apiece. Savoys were smooth and definite in their play whereas the students seemed always to be lost on the floor. The score at the end of the first half of play was 24-17 for the hotelmen but, by the time the play of the second half was over, Bo-Me-Hi was far behind. It seems that "Doc" Montgomery's months of patient coaching came through last night when the Savoy quintet put on one of the best displays of "block playing" that has been seen here in a very long time. **CASSIAR DOCKS 2 DAYS AHEAD**

Anticipating the possibility that he might have to make an extra run to the Islands to handle Christmas traffic, Capt. Lorne Godfrey brought the Union steamer Cassiar to port here at 7:30 this morning, two days ahead of its regular schedule. The vessel left Vancouver on Saturday and called at south Queen Charlotte Islands points where they picked up 66 loggers as passengers for Prince Rupert. Most of the passengers are continuing on to Vancouver to spend the Christmas season when the logging camps are closed down.

However, since traffic conditions do not make an extra trip to the south Islands necessary, the Cassiar will remain here until Friday when it will make its usual trip to Massett and Port Clements.

Crew of the Cassiar reported a quiet trip and said that, in spite of gale warnings, the vessel made good time from Vancouver.
