**WANT ANSWER ON DRY DOCK**

**Urgency of Immediate Action Being Impressed Upon Prime Minister**

The Prince Rupert "Jobs For All" Association, at a meeting last night, decided to wire Prime Minister Mackenzie King requesting a definite statement in regard to future policy respecting the local shipyard. The wire continued: "We would stress urgency of a speedy reply to the communication since final lay-off is imminent this week. All facts indicate that the Canadian National management is doing utmost to avoid continued operation. Such a situation would seem to render a government inquiry pertinent."

Should an unfavorable reply be forthcoming, it will be urged that all organizations wire the government protesting unitedly at the situation.

The association also requested the government to call a halt to the "smear campaign" at present being directed against the Labor-Progressive Party and the Canadian-Soviet Friendship Council and labor in general with the obvious aim of damaging beyond repair Canadian co-operation and friendship with the Union of Soviet Republics.

It is also being asked that the War Measures Act which, it was claimed, allows the traditions of British justice to be set aside, be immediately repealed and every effort be made to ensure continued friendly co-operation with the USSR.

The meeting, approving of a letter published on Saturday for the Plumbers' and Steamfitters' Union, urged that the city council take immediate action to provide improved quarters for Pioneers' Home. Staff houses, however, were not considered suitable in view of two-storey character.

**HOW CAN I ???**

Q. How can I preserve new gilt frames?

A. Cover gilt frames with a coat of white varnish while they are still new, and all specks and dirt can be washed off with water without injury to the frames.

Q. How can I remove mud stains from silk?

A. Rub the spots with a piece of flannel. If this does not give satisfactory results, rub with a piece of linen dipped in alcohol.

Q. How can I clean tan shoes?

A. Sweet cream is excellent for cleaning tan or white shoes. Put it on a cloth and rub in thoroughly.

**ALEXANDER DUE IN CANADA SOON**

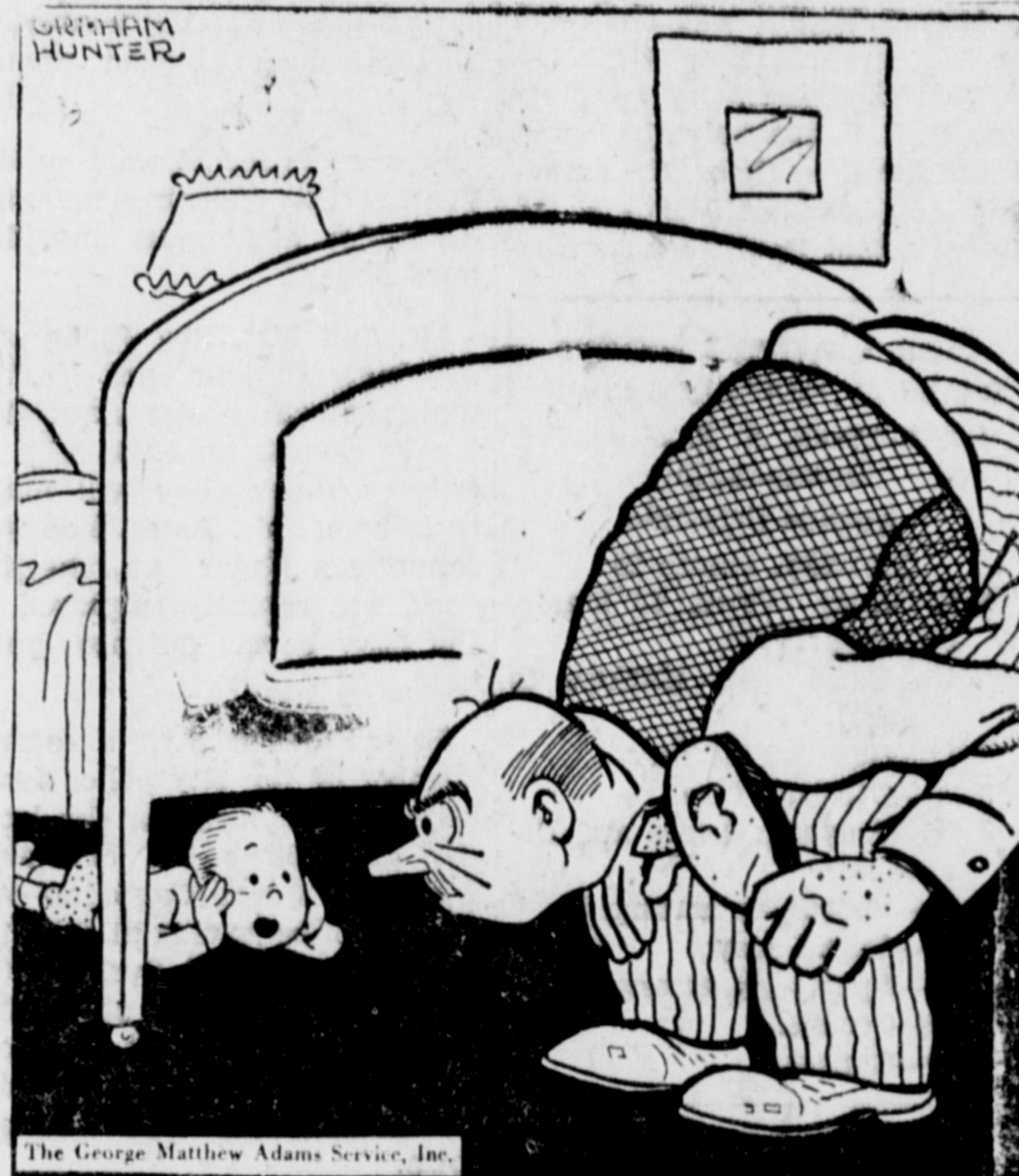
**New Governor General Is Expected on Aquitania at Halifax April 10**
