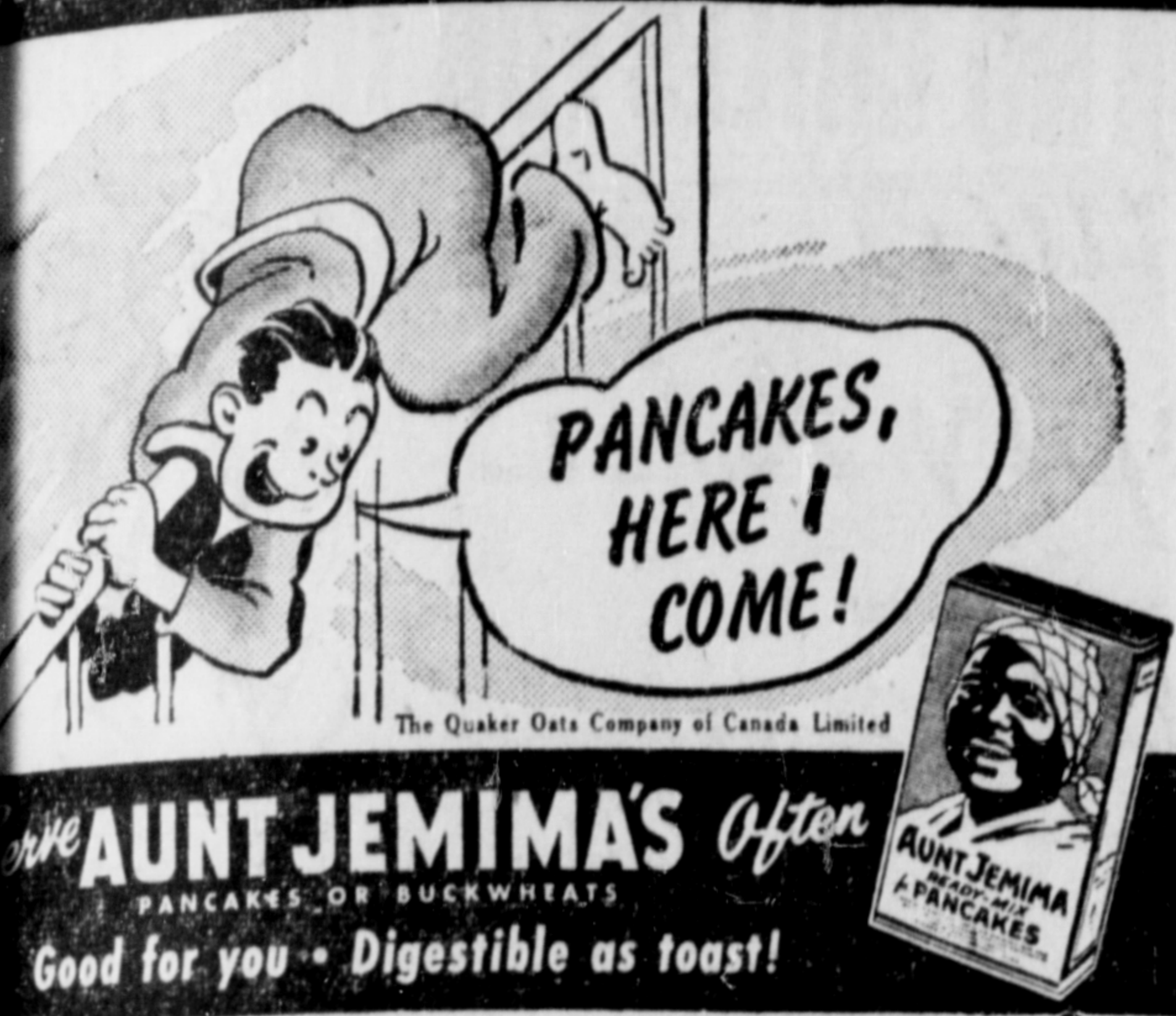

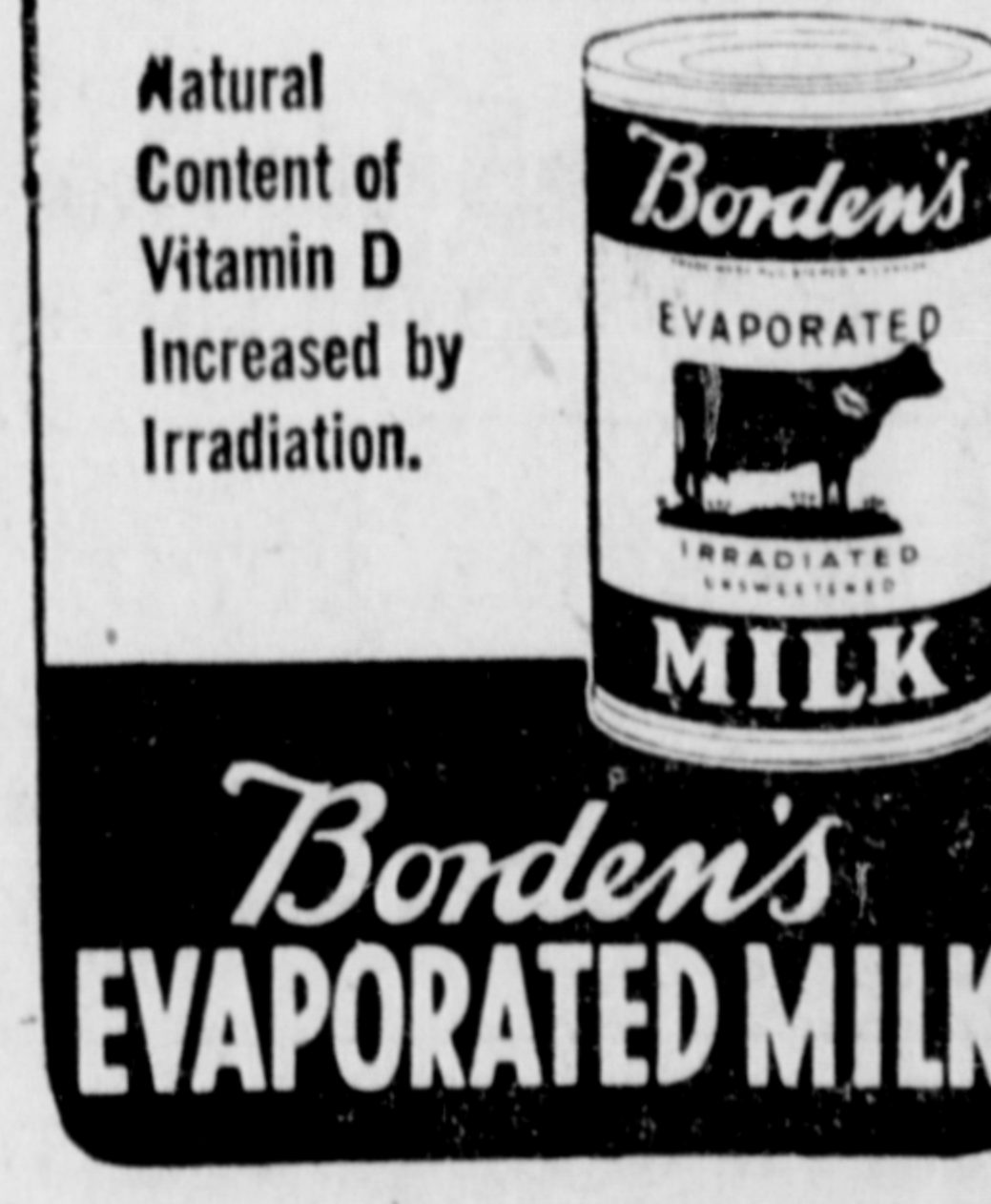
1st. (R) Bn. Prince Rupert Regt. (MG)
