Herring canning operations at Nelson Bros cannery at Port Edward ceased today after the plant had put up one of the smallest packs in years. Since opening in January, the Nelson Bros cannery, only herring cannery operating near Prince Rupert, has canned about 54,000 cases of herring. The herring run on the north coast this year has been extremely poor.

NATIVES ON TO OTTAWA

This Will be Important Business Between Now and Next Convention

With the next general convention of the Native Brotherhood of British Columbia to be held at Massett during the fall of this year at a date to be specified later by the executive. Most important activity between now and the convention will be the sending of a strong delegation to Ottawa during the coming session of Parliament to advise in connection with proposed legislation having to do with extensive revision of the Indian Act. This delegation will consist of Rev. Peter Kelly, William Scow, Guy Williams and Thomas Gosnell.

Also before the next convention the executive, among other things, will study amendments to the Brotherhood's constitution. One of these will be the re-creating of executive offices to provide for president, first and second vice-president and secretary treasurer. Regional vice-presidents will be eliminated and, instead, there will be district organizers.
