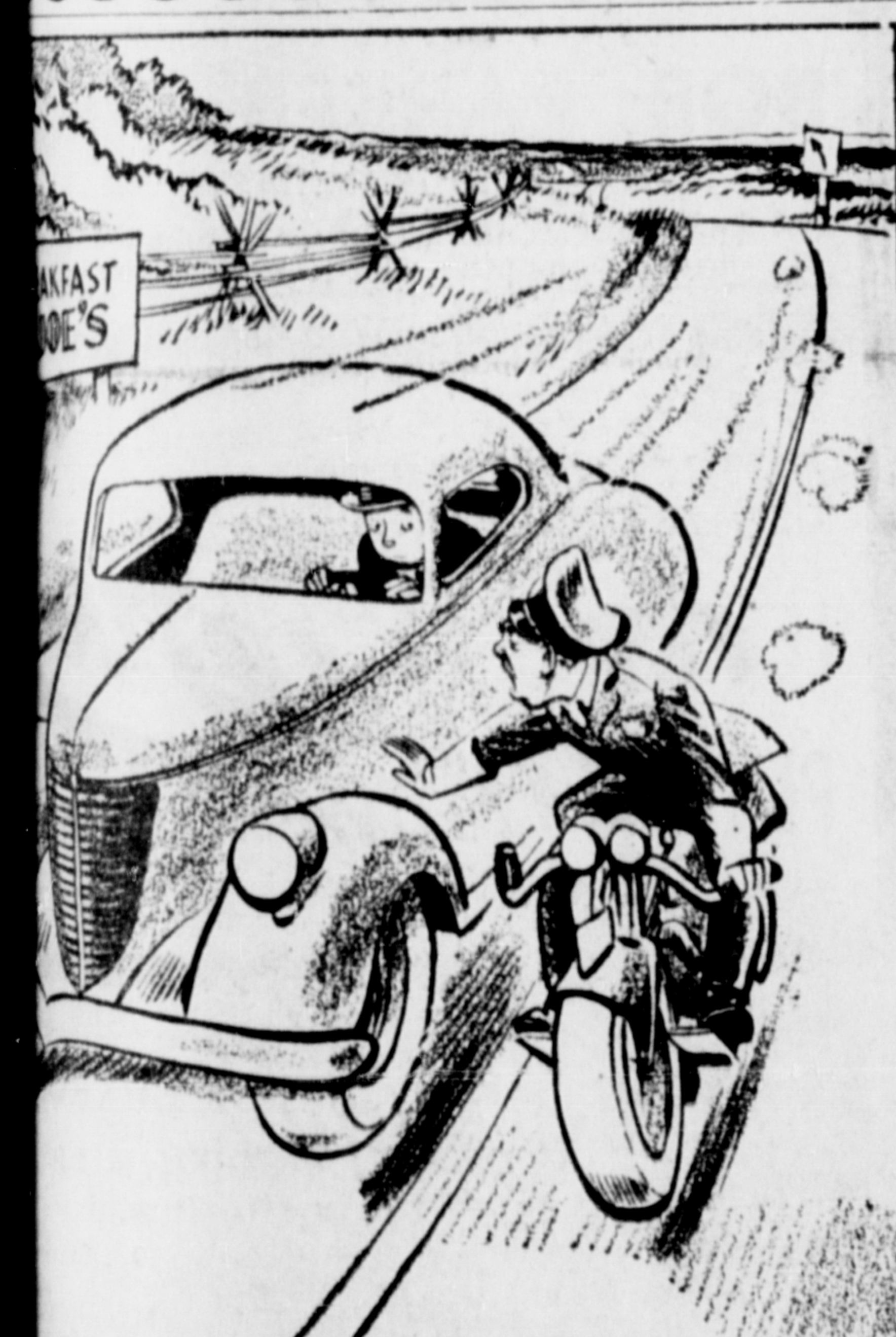

## Lutheran Church Official Is Here

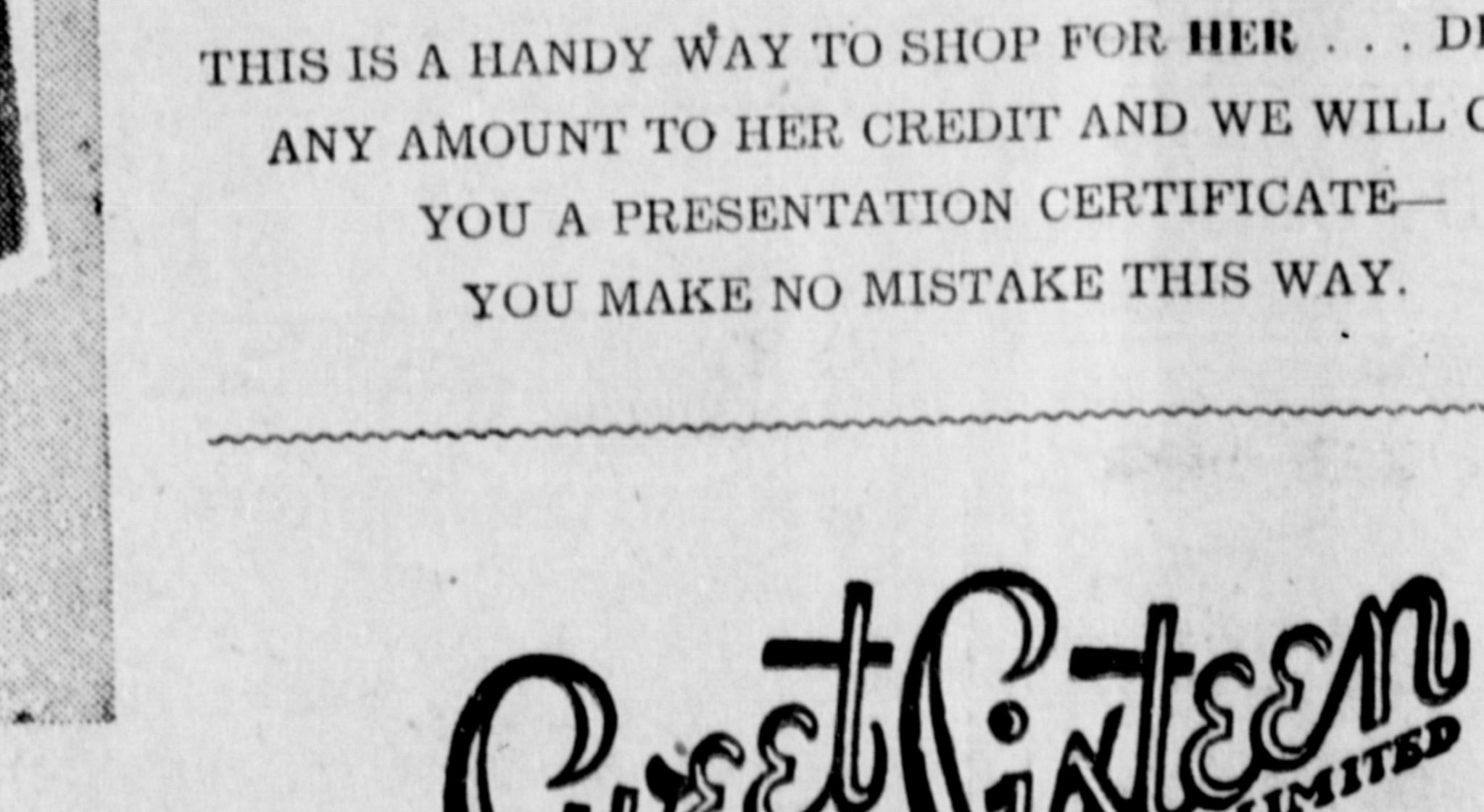
